[A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 526 (MCL 600.526).]

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 526. (1) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE twenty-fifth judicial circuit consists of the county of Marquette and has 2 judges.
 - (2) BEGINNING ON THE EARLIER OF THE FOLLOWING DATES, THE TWENTY-FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT HAS 1 JUDGE:
 - (A) THE DATE ON WHICH A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF CIRCUIT JUDGE IN THE TWENTY-FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT.
 - (B) THE BEGINNING DATE OF THE TERM FOR WHICH AN INCUMBENT CIRCUIT JUDGE IN THE TWENTY-FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT NO LONGER SEEKS ELECTION OR REELECTION TO THAT OFFICE.
