



HOUSE BILL No. 5581

May 1, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Potvin, Forlini, Jenkins and Ananich and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 8317 (MCL 324.8317), as amended by 2008 PA 18.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8317. (1) An application submitted under this part shall
2 be accompanied by the following application fee:

3 (a) For a commercial applicator certification, \$75.00.

4 (b) For a private agricultural applicator certification,
5 \$50.00 until September 30, ~~2012-2015~~ and \$10.00 after September 30,
6 ~~2012-2015~~.

7 (c) For a commercial registered applicator, \$45.00.

8 (d) For a private registered applicator, \$50.00 until
9 September 30, ~~2012-2015~~ and \$10.00 after September 30, ~~2012-2015~~.

10 (2) Certificates for commercial applicators, private
11 agricultural applicators, and registered applicators shall be valid

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1 for a period of time of not less than 3 years to be established by
2 rule by the director.

3 (3) The license application fee for a commercial applicator
4 license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on December 31.

5 (4) The registration application fee for the registration of
6 pesticides sold, offered for sale, exposed for sale, or distributed
7 is \$40.00 per product.

8 (5) The license application fee for a restricted use pesticide
9 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on
10 December 31.

11 (6) The license application fee for an agricultural pesticide
12 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on
13 December 31.

14 (7) Application fees submitted under this section are not
15 refundable.

**[(8) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, THE
DEPARTMENT SHALL WAIVE ANY FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION
IF THE INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE FEE IS, AND PROVIDES PROOF
SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT HE OR SHE IS, AN HONORABLY
DISCHARGED VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.**

16 **(9) ~~(8)~~** The department shall deposit license and administrative
17 fees and administrative, civil, and noncriminal fines received, as
18 well as any payment for costs or reimbursement to the department
19 for investigation, under this part in the agriculture licensing and
20 inspection fees fund created in section 9 of the insect pest and
21 plant disease act, 1931 PA 189, MCL 286.209, to be used, pursuant
22 to appropriation, by the director in administering and carrying out
23 those duties required by law under this part.
