SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4249

A bill to provide statewide uniformity in requirements for employers to provide leave to their employees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "employment leave uniformity act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Employee" means an individual employed in this state by
- 5 an employer.
- 6 (b) "Employer" means a person engaging in any activity,
- 7 enterprise, or business in this state.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a county,
- 9 township, city, village, or other political subdivision within this
- 10 state shall not adopt or administer an ordinance, policy, or
- 11 resolution requiring an employer to provide an employee with paid

- 1 or unpaid leave from employment that is not required under federal
- 2 law or the law of this state.
- 3 (2) This act does not prohibit an ordinance, policy, or
- 4 resolution concerning leave or other absences of an employee of the
- 5 county, township, city, village, or other political subdivision
- 6 that adopts the ordinance, policy, or resolution.
- 7 Sec. 4. Any action by a county, township, city, village, or
- 8 other political subdivision that is inconsistent with this act is
- 9 void.
- 10 Sec. 5. This act shall not be construed to affect any court
- 11 decision or litigation regarding any county, township, city,
- 12 village, or other political subdivision wage ordinance, policy, or
- 13 resolution that is decided or pending before this act takes effect.
