## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4928

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled "Probate code of 1939,"

(MCL 710.21 to 712B.41) by adding section 23g to chapter X.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER X
- 2 SEC. 23G. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), TO THE
- 3 FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY STATE AND FEDERAL LAW, INCLUDING, BUT
- 4 NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOSTER CARE AND ADOPTION SERVICES ACT, 1994 PA
- 5 203, MCL 722.951 TO 722.960, AND THE MULTIETHNIC PLACEMENT ACT OF
- 6 1994, 42 USC 1996B, A CHILD PLACING AGENCY SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO
- 7 PROVIDE ADOPTION SERVICES IF THOSE ADOPTION SERVICES CONFLICT WITH,
- 8 AND SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ADOPTION SERVICES UNDER
- 9 CIRCUMSTANCES THAT CONFLICT WITH, THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S

- 1 SINCERELY HELD RELIGIOUS BELIEFS CONTAINED IN A WRITTEN POLICY,
- 2 STATEMENT OF FAITH, OR OTHER DOCUMENT ADHERED TO BY THE CHILD
- 3 PLACING AGENCY.
- 4 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (5), TO THE
- 5 FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY STATE AND FEDERAL LAW, INCLUDING, BUT
- 6 NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOSTER CARE AND ADOPTION SERVICES ACT, 1994 PA
- 7 203, MCL 722.951 TO 722.960, AND THE MULTIETHNIC PLACEMENT ACT OF
- 8 1994, 42 USC 1996B, THE STATE OR A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT SHALL
- 9 NOT DISCRIMINATE OR TAKE AN ADVERSE ACTION AGAINST A CHILD PLACING
- 10 AGENCY ON THE BASIS THAT THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY HAS DECLINED OR
- 11 WILL DECLINE TO PROVIDE ADOPTION SERVICES THAT CONFLICT WITH, OR
- 12 HAS DECLINED OR WILL DECLINE TO PROVIDE ADOPTION SERVICES UNDER
- 13 CIRCUMSTANCES THAT CONFLICT WITH, THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S
- 14 SINCERELY HELD RELIGIOUS BELIEFS CONTAINED IN A WRITTEN POLICY,
- 15 STATEMENT OF FAITH, OR OTHER DOCUMENT ADHERED TO BY THE CHILD
- 16 PLACING AGENCY.
- 17 (3) A CHILD PLACING AGENCY UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT
- 18 MAY, UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2), DECLINE TO PROVIDE ADOPTION
- 19 SERVICES REFERRED FROM THE DEPARTMENT ONLY IN 1 OF THE FOLLOWING
- 20 CIRCUMSTANCES:
- 21 (A) THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY DECLINES TO PROVIDE THE ADOPTION
- 22 SERVICES BEFORE THE COMPLETION OF A CHILD ADOPTIVE ASSESSMENT FOR
- 23 AN ADOPTIVE PLACEMENT.
- 24 (B) THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY DECLINES TO PROVIDE THE ADOPTION
- 25 SERVICES AFTER THE COMPLETION OF A CHILD ADOPTIVE ASSESSMENT FOR AN
- 26 ADOPTIVE PLACEMENT IF DECLINING TO PROVIDE THE ADOPTION SERVICES
- 27 WILL NOT DELAY A PLACEMENT OR PERMANENT PLACEMENT OF THE CHILD AND

- 1 WILL NOT HARM THE CHILD.
- 2 (4) IF A CHILD PLACING AGENCY DECLINES TO PROVIDE ADOPTION
- 3 SERVICES UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY SHALL DO 1
- 4 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) USE ITS BEST EFFORTS TO PROMPTLY REFER THE APPLICANT OR
- 6 ADOPTION CASE TO ANOTHER CHILD PLACING AGENCY THAT IS WILLING AND
- 7 ABLE TO PROVIDE THE DECLINED ADOPTION SERVICES.
- 8 (B) PROMPTLY REFER THE APPLICANT OR ADOPTION CASE TO THE
- 9 DEPARTMENT.
- 10 (C) IF THE DEPARTMENT REFERRED THE APPLICANT OR ADOPTION CASE
- 11 TO THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY, PROMPTLY PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE
- 12 DEPARTMENT THAT ANOTHER REFERRAL IS NECESSARY.
- 13 (5) THE STATE MAY TAKE AN ADVERSE ACTION AGAINST A CHILD
- 14 PLACING AGENCY THAT FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (4).
- 15 (6) A CHILD PLACING AGENCY MAY ASSERT A DEFENSE IN AN
- 16 ADMINISTRATIVE OR JUDICIAL PROCEEDING BASED ON THIS SECTION.
- 17 (7) IF A CHILD PLACING AGENCY DECLINES TO PROVIDE ADOPTION
- 18 SERVICES UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S DECISION
- 19 DOES NOT LIMIT THE ABILITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OR ANOTHER CHILD
- 20 PLACING AGENCY TO PROVIDE THE ADOPTION SERVICES.
- 21 (8) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION:
- 22 (A) "ADOPTION SERVICES" INCLUDES COMPLETING A CHILD ADOPTIVE
- 23 ASSESSMENT FOR AN ADOPTIVE PLACEMENT FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OR
- 24 INDIVIDUALS WHO DESIRE TO ADOPT A CHILD OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING
- 25 IN A PLACEMENT.
- 26 (B) "ADVERSE ACTION" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, DENYING
- 27 A CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S APPLICATION FOR FUNDING, REFUSING TO RENEW

- 1 THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S FUNDING, CANCELING THE CHILD PLACING
- 2 AGENCY'S FUNDING, DECLINING TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CHILD
- 3 PLACING AGENCY, REFUSING TO RENEW A CONTRACT WITH THE CHILD PLACING
- 4 AGENCY, CANCELING A CONTRACT WITH THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY,
- 5 DECLINING TO ISSUE A LICENSE TO THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY, REFUSING
- 6 TO RENEW THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S LICENSE, CANCELING THE CHILD
- 7 PLACING AGENCY'S LICENSE, AND ANY ACTION THAT MATERIALLY ALTERS THE
- 8 TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S FUNDING,
- 9 CONTRACT, OR LICENSE.
- 10 Enacting section 1. It is the intent of the legislature to
- 11 protect child placing agencies' free exercise of religion protected
- 12 by the United States constitution and the state constitution of
- 13 1963. This amendatory act is not intended to limit or deny any
- 14 person's right to adopt a child.
- 15 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are
- 17 enacted into law:
