## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 76

A bill to amend 1994 PA 295, entitled "Sex offenders registration act,"

by amending section 34 (MCL 28.734), as amended by 2005 PA 322.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 34. (1) Except as provided in this section and section
- 2 36, an individual required to be registered under article II shall
- 3 not do 1 or more of the following:
- 4 (a) Work within a student safety zone.
- 5 (b) Loiter within a student safety zone.
- 6 (C) IF THE INDIVIDUAL WAS CONVICTED OF COMMITTING A LISTED
- 7 OFFENSE AGAINST A MINOR, LOITER WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A CHILD CARE
- 8 CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER DURING THE REGULAR HOURS OF OPERATION OF
- 9 THAT CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER. AS USED IN THIS
- 10 SUBDIVISION, "CHILD CARE CENTER" OR "DAY CARE CENTER" MEANS A CHILD

- 1 CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN
- 2 SECTION 1 OF 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111, AND AS LICENSED UNDER
- 3 SECTION 5 OF 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.115.
- 4 (2) An individual who violates this section is guilty of a
- 5 crime as follows:
- 6 (a) For the first violation, the individual is guilty of a
- 7 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 8 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 9 (b) An individual who violates this section and has 1 or more
- 10 prior convictions under this section is guilty of a felony
- 11 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of
- 12 not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 13 (3) Subsection (1)(a) does not apply to any of the following:
- 14 (a) An individual who was working within a student safety zone
- on January 1, 2006. However, this exception does not apply to an
- 16 individual who initiates or maintains contact with a minor within
- 17 that student safety zone.
- 18 (b) An individual whose place of employment is within a
- 19 student safety zone solely because a school is relocated or is
- 20 initially established 1,000 feet or less from the individual's
- 21 place of employment. However, this exception does not apply to an
- 22 individual who initiates or maintains contact with a minor within
- 23 that student safety zone.
- 24 (c) An individual who only intermittently or sporadically
- 25 enters a student safety zone for the purpose of work. However, this
- 26 exception does not apply to an individual who initiates or
- 27 maintains contact with a minor within a student safety zone.

- 1 (4) SUBSECTION (1) (A) TO (C) DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY OF THE
- 2 FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WITHIN A STUDENT SAFETY ZONE WHILE
- 4 TRANSPORTING HIS OR HER CHILD TO OR FROM SCHOOL OR TO OR FROM AN
- 5 EVENT SANCTIONED BY THAT SCHOOL.
- 6 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WITHIN A STUDENT SAFETY ZONE FOR THE
- 7 PURPOSE OF MEETING WITH AN EMPLOYEE OF THE SCHOOL REGARDING HIS OR
- 8 HER CHILD ENROLLED AT THAT SCHOOL.
- 9 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A CHILD CARE
- 10 CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER WHILE TRANSPORTING HIS OR HER CHILD TO OR
- 11 FROM THAT CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER OR TO OR FROM AN
- 12 EVENT SANCTIONED BY THAT CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER.
- 13 (D) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A CHILD CARE
- 14 CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING WITH AN
- 15 EMPLOYEE OF THE CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER REGARDING HIS
- 16 OR HER CHILD ENROLLED AT THAT CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER.
- 17 (5) (4)—This section does not prohibit an individual from
- 18 being charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other
- 19 violation of law that is committed by that individual while
- 20 violating this section.
- 21 (6) (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit
- 22 an individual from exercising his or her right to vote.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect April 1,
