SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 235

A bill to amend 1986 PA 54, entitled "Building officials and inspectors registration act," by amending sections 2 and 11 (MCL 338.2302 and 338.2311).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Adopted", IN REFERENCE TO A RULE OR ORDINANCE, means a
- 3 properly passed. rule or ordinance.
- 4 (b) "Advisory board" means the building officials advisory
- 5 board created pursuant to section 3.
- 6 (c) "Approved" means reviewed and found acceptable by the
- 7 commission.
- 8 (d) "Building official" means a construction code enforcement
- 9 person working as an inspector, or plan reviewer, or actively

- 1 engaged in the administration and enforcement of adopted building,
- 2 electrical, mechanical, or plumbing codes, or any combination of
- 3 these codes.
- 4 (e) "Code" means the state construction code provided for THAT
- 5 TERM AS DEFINED in section 4—2A of the STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE
- 6 state construction code act, of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public
- 7 Acts of 1972, being section 125.1504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
- 8 or a part of that code which is of limited application, and
- 9 includes a modification of or amendment to the code, or a
- 10 nationally recognized model building code or other nationally
- 11 recognized model code adopted by a governmental subdivision
- 12 pursuant to section 8 of the state construction code act of 1972,
- 13 being section 125.1508 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.1972 PA 230,
- 14 MCL 125.1502A.
- 15 (f) "Commission" means the state construction code commission
- 16 as established THAT TERM AS DEFINED in section 3-2A of the STILLE-
- 17 DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE state construction code act, of 1972, Act No.
- 18 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being section 125.1503 of the
- 19 Michigan Compiled Laws. 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1502A.
- 20 (g) "Education or training program" means formal or informal
- 21 courses, seminars, correspondence programs, and other teaching aids
- 22 APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION for building officials, plan reviewers,
- 23 and inspectors. which have been approved by the commission.
- 24 (h) "Enforcing agency" means an enforcing agency THAT TERM as
- 25 defined in section 2—2A of the STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE STATE
- 26 construction code act, of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of
- 27 1972, being section 125.1502 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.1972 PA

- 2 (I) "FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN THE
- 3 MICHIGAN BUILDING CODE.
- 4 (J) "FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM INSPECTOR" MEANS A PERSON MEETING
- 5 THE QUALIFICATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THIS ACT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
- 6 INSPECTION OF FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DESIGN
- 7 AND INSTALLATION STANDARDS REFERENCED BY THE MICHIGAN BUILDING
- 8 CODE.
- 9 (K) "FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM PLAN REVIEWER" MEANS A PERSON
- 10 MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THIS ACT RESPONSIBLE FOR
- 11 THE REVIEW OF FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM PLANS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
- 12 DESIGN AND INSTALLATION STANDARDS REFERENCED BY THE MICHIGAN
- 13 BUILDING CODE.
- 14 (1) (i) "Inspector" means the person responsible for the
- 15 administration and enforcement of the construction of buildings,
- 16 structures, or appurtenances under the requirements of the
- 17 applicable building, electrical, mechanical, or plumbing code
- 18 administered and enforced within the jurisdiction of the employing
- 19 enforcing agency employing the person. CODE.
- 20 (M) (j) "Practical construction experience" means experience
- 21 in construction related trades or code administration and
- 22 enforcement which THAT is found to be acceptable to the commission.
- 23 (N) (k) "Plan reviewer" means a person engaged in the practice
- 24 of examining construction documents for the purpose of determining
- 25 compliance with applicable codes.
- 26 (O) (I)—"Provisional registration" means a building official,
- 27 plan reviewer, or inspector who is registered subject to attaining

- 1 the amount of training, education, and experience required by the
- 2 appropriate board and the commission.
- 3 (P) (m) "Registered" means a building official, plan reviewer,
- 4 or inspector who is registered under this act.
- 5 (Q) (n) "Test" means a method of determining the
- 6 qualifications of a person seeking registration as a building
- 7 official, plan reviewer, or inspector under this act. Tests may be
- 8 written, oral, practical, or a combination of written, oral, and
- 9 practical. Completion of educational EDUCATION or training programs
- 10 which have been approved by the commission may be substituted for
- 11 appropriate tests or portions of tests.
- (R) (O) "Code change cycle" means the publication by a
- 13 nationally recognized code writing body of a new edition of a basic
- 14 code which includes all approved changes to the basic code since
- 15 the previous edition. Code change cycle does not include changes to
- 16 the basic code approved and published in annual supplements to the
- **17** code.
- 18 Sec. 11. (1) Upon payment to the commission RECEIPT of the fee
- 19 prescribed in section 13, the commission, WITHOUT REQUIRING AN
- 20 EXAMINATION, shall register and OR reregister, without examination
- 21 applicants AS A BUILDING OFFICIAL, INSPECTOR, OR PLAN REVIEWER, AN
- 22 APPLICANT licensed or certified under the laws of other states
- 23 ANOTHER STATE or BY A national organizations having requirements
- 24 for certified or licensed building officials, inspectors, or plan
- 25 reviewers which ORGANIZATION AS A BUILDING OFFICIAL, INSPECTOR, OR
- 26 PLAN REVIEWER. HOWEVER, THE COMMISSION SHALL REGISTER OR REREGISTER
- 27 THE APPLICANT ONLY IF the commission determines THAT THE LICENSING

- 1 OR CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE OTHER STATE OR OTHER NATIONAL
- 2 ORGANIZATION are equivalent to the requirements of this state for
- 3 the purpose of establishing reciprocity privileges for building
- 4 officials, inspectors, and plan reviewers.
- 5 (2) UPON RECEIPT OF THE FEE PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 13, THE
- 6 COMMISSION, WITHOUT REQUIRING AN EXAMINATION, SHALL REGISTER OR
- 7 REREGISTER AS A FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS PLAN REVIEWER AN APPLICANT
- 8 WHO IS CERTIFIED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION OR THE
- 9 INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL AS BOTH A FIRE INSPECTOR I AND A FIRE
- 10 PLANS EXAMINER. THE REGISTRATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ONLY
- 11 AUTHORIZES THE APPLICANT TO CONDUCT PLAN REVIEWS ON FIRE PROTECTION
- 12 SYSTEMS.
- 13 (3) UPON RECEIPT OF THE FEE PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 13, THE
- 14 COMMISSION, WITHOUT REQUIRING AN EXAMINATION, SHALL REGISTER OR
- 15 REREGISTER AS A FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS INSPECTOR AN APPLICANT WHO
- 16 IS CERTIFIED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION OR THE
- 17 INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL AS A FIRE INSPECTOR II. THE REGISTRATION
- 18 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ONLY AUTHORIZES THE APPLICANT TO INSPECT FIRE
- 19 PROTECTION SYSTEMS.
