SENATE BILL NO. 523

A bill to amend 1982 PA 295, entitled
"Support and parenting time enforcement act,"
by amending section 2 (MCL 552.602), as amended by 2009 PA 193.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Account" means any of the following:
- 3 (i) A demand deposit account.
- 4 (ii) A draft account.
- 5 (iii) A checking account.
- 6 (iv) A negotiable order of withdrawal account.
- (v) A share account.
- 8 (vi) A savings account.
- 9 (vii) A time savings account.
- 10 (viii) A mutual fund account.
- 11 (ix) A securities brokerage account.

- 1 (x) A money market account.
- 2 (xi) A retail investment account.
- 3 (xii) AN INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNT.
- 4 (b) "Account" does not mean any of the following:
- (i) A trust.
- 6 (ii) An annuity.
- 7 (iii) A qualified individual retirement account.
- 8 (iii) (iv) An account covered by the employee retirement income9 security act of 1974, Public Law 93-406.
- 10 (iv) $\frac{(v)}{(v)}$ A pension or retirement plan.

- 12 (c) "Cash" means money or the equivalent of money, such as a
- 13 money order, cashier's check, or negotiable check or a payment by
- 14 debit or credit card, which equivalent is accepted as cash by the
- 15 agency accepting the payment.
- 16 (d) "Custody or parenting time order violation" means an
- 17 individual's act or failure to act that interferes with a parent's
- 18 right to interact with his or her child in the time, place, and
- 19 manner established in the order that governs custody or parenting
- 20 time between the parent and the child and to which the individual
- 21 accused of interfering is subject.
- (e) "Department" means the department of human services.
- 23 (f) "Domestic relations matter" means a circuit court
- 24 proceeding as to child custody, parenting time, child support, or
- 25 spousal support, that arises out of litigation under a statute of
- 26 this state, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 14 (h) "Employer" means an individual, sole proprietorship,
- 15 partnership, association, or private or public corporation, the
- 16 United States or a federal agency, this state or a political
- 17 subdivision of this state, another state or a political subdivision
- 18 of another state, or another legal entity that hires and pays an
- 19 individual for his or her services.
- (i) "Financial asset" means a deposit, account, money market
- 21 fund, stock, bond, or similar instrument.
- 22 (j) "Financial institution" means any of the following:
- 23 (i) A state or national bank.
- 24 (ii) A state or federally chartered savings and loan
- 25 association.
- 26 (iii) A state or federally chartered savings bank.
- 27 (iv) A state or federally chartered credit union.

- (vi) An entity that offers any of the following to a resident

- 4 (A) A mutual fund account.
- 5 (B) A securities brokerage account.

- 9 commission that collects funds from the public.

- 14 act, 1982 PA 294, MCL 552.501 to 552.535.
- 15 (l) "Friend of the court case" means that term as defined in
- 16 section 2 of the friend of the court act, MCL 552.502.
- 17 (m) "Income" means any of the following:
- 18 (i) Commissions, earnings, salaries, wages, and other income
- 19 due or to be due in the future to an individual from his or her
- 20 employer or a successor employer.
- 21 (ii) A payment due or to be due in the future to an individual
- 22 from a profit-sharing plan, a pension plan, an insurance contract,
- 23 an annuity, social security, unemployment compensation,
- 24 supplemental unemployment benefits, or worker's compensation.
- 25 (iii) An amount of money that is due to an individual as a debt
- 26 of another individual, partnership, association, or private or
- 27 public corporation, the United States or a federal agency, this

- 4 (n) "Insurer" means an insurer, health maintenance
- 5 organization, health care corporation, or other group, plan, or

- 10 (ii) The insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.100 to

- 14 (o) "Medical assistance" means medical assistance as
- 15 established under title XIX of the social security act, 42 USC 1396
- 16 to $\frac{1396 \text{ v.}}{1396 \text{ W-5}}$.
- 17 (p) "Most recent semiannual obligation" means the total amount
- 18 of current child support owed by a parent during the preceding
- 19 January 1 to June 30 or July 1 to December 31.
- 20 (q) "Occupational license" means a certificate, registration,
- 21 or license issued by a state department, bureau, or agency that has
- 22 regulatory authority over an individual that allows an individual
- 23 to legally engage in a regulated occupation or that allows the
- 24 individual to use a specific title in the practice of an
- 25 occupation, profession, or vocation.
- 26 (r) "Office of child support" means the office of child
- 27 support established in section 2 of the office of child support

- 2 (s) "Office of the friend of the court" means an agency
- 3 created in section 3 of the friend of the court act, MCL 552.503.
- 4 (t) "Order of income withholding" means an order entered by
- 5 the circuit court providing for the withholding of a payer's income
- 6 to enforce a support order under this act.
- 7 (u) "Payer" means an individual who is ordered by the circuit
- 8 court to pay support.
- 9 (v) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 10 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 11 (w) "Plan administrator" means that term as used in relation
- 12 to a group health plan under section 609 of title I of the employee
- 13 retirement income security act of 1974, 29 USC 1169, if the health
- 14 care coverage plan of the individual who is responsible for
- 15 providing a child with health care coverage is subject to that act.
- 16 (x) "Political subdivision" means a county, city, village,
- 17 township, educational institution, school district, or special
- 18 district or authority of this state or of a local unit of
- 19 government.
- 20 (y) "Recipient of support" means the following:
- (i) The spouse, if the support order orders spousal support.
- 22 (ii) The custodial parent or guardian, if the support order
- 23 orders support for a minor child or a child who is 18 years of age
- 24 or older.
- 25 (iii) The department, if support has been assigned to that
- 26 department.
- 27 (iv) The county, if the minor child is in county-funded foster

- 2 (z) "Recreational or sporting license" means a hunting,
- 3 fishing, or fur harvester's license issued under the natural
- 4 resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL
- 5 324.101 to 324.90106, but does not include a commercial fishing
- 6 license or permit issued under part 473 of the natural resources
- 7 and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.47301 to
- 8 324.47362.
- 9 (aa) "Referee" means a person who is designated as a referee
- 10 under the friend of the court act.
- 11 (bb) "Source of income" means an employer or successor
- 12 employer, a labor organization, or another individual or entity
- 13 that owes or will owe income to the payer.
- 14 (cc) "State disbursement unit" or "SDU" means the entity
- 15 established in section 6 of the office of child support act, 1971
- **16** PA 174, MCL 400.236.
- 17 (dd) "State friend of the court bureau" means that bureau as
- 18 created in the state court administrative office under section 19
- 19 of the friend of the court act, MCL 552.519.
- 20 (ee) "Support" means all of the following:
- (i) The payment of money for a child or a spouse ordered by the
- 22 circuit court, whether the order is embodied in an interim,
- 23 temporary, permanent, or modified order or judgment. Support may
- 24 include payment of the expenses of medical, dental, and other
- 25 health care, child care expenses, and educational expenses.
- 26 (ii) The payment of money ordered by the circuit court under
- 27 the paternity act, 1956 PA 205, MCL 722.711 to 722.730, for the

- 1 necessary expenses connected to the mother's pregnancy or the birth
- 2 of the child, or for the repayment of genetic testing expenses.
- 3 (iii) A surcharge under section 3a.
- 4 (ff) "Support order" means an order entered by the circuit
- 5 court for the payment of support, whether or not a sum certain.
- 6 (gg) "Title IV-D" means part D of title IV of the social
- 7 security act, 42 USC 651 to 669b.
- 8 (hh) "Title IV-D agency" means the agency in this state
- 9 performing the functions under title IV-D and includes a person
- 10 performing those functions under contract, including an office of
- 11 the friend of the court or a prosecuting attorney.
- 12 (ii) "Work activity" means any of the following:
- 13 (i) Unsubsidized employment.
- 14 (ii) Subsidized private sector employment.
- 15 (iii) Subsidized public sector employment.
- 16 (iv) Work experience, including work associated with the
- 17 refurbishing of publicly assisted housing, if sufficient private
- 18 sector employment is not available.
- 19 (v) On-the-job training.
- 20 (vi) Referral to and participation in the work first PATH:
- 21 PARTNERSHIP. ACCOUNTABILITY. TRAINING. HOPE. WORK PARTNERSHIP
- 22 program prescribed in the social welfare act, 1939 PA 280, MCL
- 23 400.1 to 400.119b, or other job search and job readiness
- 24 assistance.
- 25 (vii) A community service program.
- 26 (viii) Vocational educational training, not to exceed 12 months
- 27 with respect to an individual.

- 1 (ix) Job skills training directly related to employment.
- 2 (x) Education directly related to employment, in the case of
- 3 an individual who has not received a high school diploma or a
- 4 certificate of high school equivalency.
- 5 (xi) Satisfactory attendance at secondary school or in a course
- 6 of study leading to a certificate of general equivalence, in the
- 7 case of an individual who has not completed secondary school or
- 8 received such a certificate.
- 9 (xii) The provision of child care services to an individual who
- 10 is participating in a community service program.
