## HOUSE BILL NO. 5468

A bill to amend 1966 PA 138, entitled "The family support act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 552.454), as amended by 1999 PA 158.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) If the county family independence agency
- 2 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES where the custodial parent or guardian
- 3 of the minor child or children or the child or children who have
- 4 reached 18 years of age resides determines the custodial parent,
- 5 the minor child or children, the child or children who have reached
- 6 18 years of age, or any of them to be eligible for public or
- 7 medical assistance, or if a complaint is being filed under section
- 8 1b, the prosecuting attorney shall act as the attorney for the
- 9 petitioner.
- 10 (2) THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
- 11 SERVICES MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO TRANSFER THE PROSECUTOR'S

- 1 RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS ACT TO 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) THE FRIEND OF THE COURT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE CHIEF
- 3 JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT.
- 4 (B) AN ATTORNEY EMPLOYED OR CONTRACTED BY THE COUNTY UNDER
- 5 SECTION 1 OF 1941 PA 14, MCL 49.71.
- 6 (C) AN ATTORNEY EMPLOYED BY, OR UNDER CONTRACT WITH, THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.
- 8 (3) A PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SECTION IS CONDUCTED ON BEHALF OF
- 9 THE STATE AND NOT AS THE ATTORNEY FOR ANY OTHER PARTY.
- 10 (4) (2) The prosecuting attorney shall utilize the child
- 11 support formula developed under section 19 of the friend of the
- 12 court act, 1982 PA 294, MCL 552.519, SHALL BE USED as a guideline
- 13 in petitioning for child support. Upon certification by the family
- 14 independence agency DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES that the custodial
- 15 parent and minor child or children or child or children who have
- 16 reached 18 years of age are receiving public assistance, a payment
- 17 received by the friend of the court or the state disbursement unit
- 18 for the support of the custodial parent and minor child or children
- 19 or child or children who have reached 18 years of age shall be
- 20 transmitted to the family independence agency. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
- 21 SERVICES.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 23 after the date it is enacted into law.
