SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 935

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17001 (MCL 333.17001), as amended by 2006 PA 161, and by adding sections 16326, 17091, 17092, 17093, 17094, 17095, and 17096.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 16326. FEES FOR A PERSON LICENSED OR SEEKING LICENSURE
- 2 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING UNDER PART 170
- 3 ARE AS FOLLOWS:

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4	(A) APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE	\$ 55.00
5	(B) LICENSE FEE, PER YEAR	95.00
6	(C) TEMPORARY LICENSE FEE, PER YEAR	50.00
7	Sec. 17001. (1) As used in this part:	

(a) "Academic institution" means either of the following:

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- 1 (i) A medical school approved by the board.
- 2 (ii) A hospital licensed under article 17 that meets all of
- 3 the following requirements:
- 4 (A) Was the sole sponsor or a co-sponsor, if each other co-
- 5 sponsor is either a medical school approved by the board or a
- 6 hospital owned by the federal government and directly operated by
- 7 the United States department of veterans' VETERANS affairs, of
- 8 not less than 4 postgraduate education residency programs
- 9 approved by the board under section 17031(1) for not less than
- 10 the 3 years immediately preceding the date of an application for
- 11 a limited license under section 16182(2)(c) or an application for
- 12 a full license under section 17031(2), provided that IF at least
- 13 1 of the residency programs is in the specialty area of medical
- 14 practice, or in a specialty area that includes the subspecialty
- 15 of medical practice, in which the applicant for a limited license
- 16 proposes to practice or in which the applicant for a full license
- 17 has practiced for the hospital.
- 18 (B) Has spent not less than \$2,000,000.00 for medical
- 19 education during each of the 3 years immediately preceding the
- 20 date of an application for a limited license under section
- 21 16182(2)(c) or an application for a full license under section
- 22 17031(2). As used in this subparagraph, "medical education" means
- 23 the education of physicians and candidates for degrees or
- 24 licenses to become physicians, including, but not limited to,
- 25 physician staff, residents, interns, and medical students.
- 26 (b) "Electrodiagnostic studies" means the testing of
- 27 neuromuscular functions utilizing nerve conduction tests and

- 1 needle electromyography. It does not include the use of surface
- 2 electromyography.
- 3 (C) "GENETIC COUNSELOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED UNDER
- 4 THIS PART TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING.
- 5 (D) (c) "Medical care services" means those services within
- 6 the scope of practice of physicians licensed by the board, except
- 7 those services that the board determines shall not be delegated
- 8 by a physician without endangering BECAUSE A DELEGATION WOULD
- 9 ENDANGER the health and safety of patients, as provided for in
- 10 section 17048(3).
- 11 (E) (d) "Physician" means an individual licensed under this
- 12 article to engage in the practice of medicine.
- 13 (F) (e) "Podiatrist" means an individual licensed under this
- 14 article to engage in the practice of podiatric medicine and
- 15 surgery.
- 16 (G) "PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING" MEANS PROVISION OF ANY
- 17 OF THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:
- 18 (i) OBTAINING AND EVALUATING INDIVIDUAL, FAMILY, AND MEDICAL
- 19 HISTORIES TO DETERMINE THE GENETIC RISK FOR GENETIC OR MEDICAL
- 20 CONDITIONS OR DISEASES IN A CLIENT, THE CLIENT'S DESCENDANTS, OR
- 21 OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS OF THE CLIENT.
- 22 (ii) DISCUSSING WITH A CLIENT THE FEATURES, NATURAL HISTORY,
- 23 MEANS OF DIAGNOSIS, GENETIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS, AND
- 24 MANAGEMENT OF THE GENETIC RISKS OF GENETIC OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS
- 25 OR DISEASES.
- 26 (iii) IDENTIFYING AND COORDINATING APPROPRIATE GENETIC
- 27 LABORATORY TESTS AND OTHER DIAGNOSTIC STUDIES FOR GENETIC

- 1 ASSESSMENT OF A CLIENT.
- 2 (iv) INTEGRATING GENETIC LABORATORY TEST RESULTS AND OTHER
- 3 DIAGNOSTIC STUDIES WITH PERSONAL AND FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY TO
- 4 ASSESS AND COMMUNICATE A CLIENT'S RISK FACTORS FOR GENETIC OR
- 5 MEDICAL CONDITIONS OR DISEASES.
- 6 (v) EXPLAINING TO A CLIENT THE CLINICAL IMPLICATIONS OF
- 7 GENETIC LABORATORY TESTS AND OTHER DIAGNOSTIC STUDIES AND THEIR
- 8 RESULTS.
- 9 (vi) EVALUATING THE RESPONSES OF A CLIENT AND THE CLIENT'S
- 10 FAMILY TO A GENETIC OR MEDICAL CONDITION OR DISEASE OR TO THE
- 11 RISK OF RECURRENCE OF THAT CONDITION OR DISEASE AND PROVIDING
- 12 CLIENT-CENTERED COUNSELING AND ANTICIPATORY GUIDANCE.
- 13 (vii) IDENTIFYING AND UTILIZING COMMUNITY RESOURCES THAT
- 14 PROVIDE MEDICAL, EDUCATIONAL, FINANCIAL, AND PSYCHOSOCIAL SUPPORT
- 15 AND ADVOCACY TO A CLIENT.
- 16 (viii) PROVIDING WRITTEN DOCUMENTATION OF MEDICAL, GENETIC,
- 17 AND COUNSELING INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES OF AND HEALTH CARE
- 18 PROFESSIONALS OF A CLIENT.
- 19 (H) (f) "Practice of medicine" means the diagnosis,
- 20 treatment, prevention, cure, or relieving of a human disease,
- 21 ailment, defect, complaint, or other physical or mental
- 22 condition, by attendance, advice, device, diagnostic test, or
- 23 other means, or offering, undertaking, attempting to do, or
- 24 holding oneself out as able to do, any of these acts.
- 25 (I) (g) "Practice as a physician's assistant" means the
- 26 practice of medicine, PRACTICE OF osteopathic medicine and
- 27 surgery, or PRACTICE OF podiatric medicine and surgery performed

- 1 under the supervision of a physician, or A podiatrist, OR AN
- 2 OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN licensed under this article.
- 3 (J) "QUALIFIED SUPERVISOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A
- 4 GENETIC COUNSELOR OR A PHYSICIAN.
- 5 (K) (h) "Supervision" means that term as defined in section
- 6 16109, except that it also includes the existence of a
- 7 predetermined plan for emergency situations, including, but not
- 8 limited to, the designation of a physician to supervise a
- 9 physician's assistant in the absence of the primary supervising
- 10 physician.
- 11 (l) (i)—"Task force" means the joint task force created in
- **12** section 17025.
- 13 (M) "TEMPORARY LICENSED GENETIC COUNSELOR" MEANS A GENETIC
- 14 COUNSELOR WHO HAS BEEN ISSUED A TEMPORARY LICENSE UNDER THIS
- 15 ARTICLE.
- 16 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 17 contains definitions and principles of construction applicable to
- 18 all articles in this code and part 161 contains definitions
- 19 applicable to this part.
- 20 SEC. 17091. (1) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
- 21 BOARD, SHALL PROMULGATE RULES THAT SPECIFY THE MINIMUM STANDARDS
- 22 FOR LICENSURE, TEMPORARY LICENSURE, AND LICENSE RENEWAL OF
- 23 GENETIC COUNSELORS. THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
- 24 BOARD, SHALL ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS AND
- 25 CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION STANDARDS ISSUED BY A
- 26 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CERTIFYING AGENCY FOR GENETIC COUNSELORS OR
- 27 MEDICAL GENETICISTS.

- 1 (2) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE,
- 2 THE BOARD SHALL PERFORM OTHER FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES AS NECESSARY
- 3 TO CARRY OUT THE REGULATION OF GENETIC COUNSELORS UNDER THIS
- 4 PART.
- 5 SEC. 17092. TO BE LICENSED AS A GENETIC COUNSELOR UNDER THIS
- 6 PART, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD.
- 8 (B) PAY THE FEE PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 16326.
- 9 (C) PROVIDE SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF HAVING CURRENT
- 10 CERTIFICATION THROUGH A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CERTIFYING AGENCY
- 11 FOR GENETIC COUNSELORS OR MEDICAL GENETICISTS APPROVED BY THE
- 12 BOARD.
- 13 SEC. 17093. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL
- 14 NOT ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING UNLESS HE OR SHE
- 15 IS LICENSED AS A GENETIC COUNSELOR UNDER THIS PART.
- 16 SEC. 17094. A TEMPORARY LICENSED GENETIC COUNSELOR SHALL
- 17 WORK UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A QUALIFIED SUPERVISOR AT ALL TIMES
- 18 DURING WHICH THE TEMPORARY LICENSED GENETIC COUNSELOR ENGAGES IN
- 19 THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING.
- 20 SEC. 17095. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 21 (2), AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT LICENSED AS A GENETIC COUNSELOR
- 22 UNDER THIS PART SHALL NOT USE IN CONNECTION WITH HIS OR HER NAME
- 23 OR PLACE OF BUSINESS, THE TITLE "GENETIC COUNSELOR", "LICENSED
- 24 GENETIC COUNSELOR", "GENE COUNSELOR", "GENETIC CONSULTANT",
- 25 "GENETIC ASSOCIATE" OR ANY WORDS, LETTERS, ABBREVIATIONS, OR
- 26 INSIGNIA INDICATING OR IMPLYING A PERSON HOLDS A LICENSE TO
- 27 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING UNDER THIS PART.

- (2) SECTIONS 17091 TO 17096 DO NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL 1
- 2 LICENSED BY THIS STATE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF A HEALTH
- 3 PROFESSION OTHER THAN THE PRACTICE OF GENETIC COUNSELING WHEN
- 4 ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S HEALTH PROFESSION AND
- 5 DOING WORK OF A NATURE CONSISTENT WITH THE PERSON'S EDUCATION AND
- 6 TRAINING.
- 7 SEC. 17096. TO OBTAIN A LICENSE RENEWAL AS A GENETIC
- 8 COUNSELOR UNDER THIS PART, A LICENSEE SHALL PRESENT SATISFACTORY
- 9 EVIDENCE TO THE BOARD THAT IN THE PERIOD SINCE THE LICENSE WAS
- 10 ISSUED OR LAST RENEWED THE LICENSEE HAS MAINTAINED CERTIFICATION
- 11 THROUGH A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CERTIFYING AGENCY APPROVED BY THE
- 12 BOARD.
