## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4017

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled

"Food law,"

(MCL 289.1101 to 289.8111) by amending the title and by adding section 5104.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

- 2 An act to codify the licensure and regulation of certain
- 3 persons engaged in processing, manufacturing, production, packing,
- 4 preparing, repacking, canning, preserving, freezing, fabricating,
- 5 storing, selling, serving, or offering for sale food or drink for
- 6 human consumption; to prescribe powers and duties of the department
- 7 of agriculture AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT; to provide for delegation of
- 8 certain powers and duties to certain local units of government; to

- 1 provide exemptions; to regulate the labeling, manufacture,
- 2 distribution, and sale of food for protection of the consuming
- 3 public and to prevent fraud and deception by prohibiting the
- 4 misbranding, adulteration, manufacture, distribution, and sale of
- 5 foods in violation of this act; to provide standards for food
- 6 products and food establishments; TO PROVIDE FOR IMMUNITY TO
- 7 CERTAIN PERSONS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; to provide for
- 8 enforcement of the act; to provide penalties and remedies for
- 9 violation of the act; to provide for fees; to provide for
- 10 promulgation of rules; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.
- 11 SEC. 5104. (1) A RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT, FARMER,
- 12 WHOLESALER, WHOLESALE PROCESSOR, DISTRIBUTOR, OR OTHER PERSON WHO
- 13 DONATES FOOD FOR USE OR DISTRIBUTION BY A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR
- 14 NONPROFIT CORPORATION, AND A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR NONPROFIT
- 15 CORPORATION THAT COLLECTS DONATED FOOD AND DISTRIBUTES THAT FOOD TO
- 16 ANOTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR NONPROFIT CORPORATION FREE OF
- 17 CHARGE OR FOR A NOMINAL FEE, IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY CRIMINAL
- 18 LIABILITY UNDER THIS ACT OR ANY CIVIL LIABILITY RESULTING FROM THE
- 19 NATURE, AGE, CONDITION, OR PACKAGING OF THE FOOD UNLESS THE DONOR
- 20 OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR NONPROFIT CORPORATION KNEW OR
- 21 REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN WHEN IT DONATED OR DISTRIBUTED THE
- 22 FOOD THAT THE FOOD WAS ADULTERATED OR NOT FIT FOR HUMAN
- 23 CONSUMPTION.
- 24 (2) A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR NONPROFIT CORPORATION THAT
- 25 SERVES DONATED FOOD DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL EMPLOY OR
- 26 DESIGNATE AS A FOOD SAFETY MANAGER AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CERTIFIED
- 27 UNDER A PERSONNEL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM DESCRIBED IN SECTION
