THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3t. The word "firearm", except as otherwise specifically

defined in the statutes, shall be construed to include STATUTE,

INCLUDES any weapon from which a dangerous WILL, IS DESIGNED TO, OR

MAY READILY BE CONVERTED TO EXPEL A projectile may be propelled by

using explosives, gas or air as a means of propulsion, except any
smooth bore rifle or handgun designed and manufactured exclusively
for propelling BB's not exceeding .177 calibre by means of spring,
gas or air.BY ACTION OF AN EXPLOSIVE.

2015.
