

HOUSE BILL No. 4319

March 11, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Nesbitt and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 669 (MCL 257.669), as amended by 2002 PA 534.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 669. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2), (3), and
- 2 (4), the driver of a motor vehicle transporting 16 or more
- 3 passengers including the driver, a motor vehicle carrying
- 4 passengers for hire, or a motor vehicle that is required to be
- 5 marked or placarded under 49 C.F.R. CFR parts 100 to 180, before
- 6 crossing a railroad track at grade, shall activate the vehicle
- 7 hazard warning lights and stop the vehicle within 50 feet but not
- 8 less than 15 feet from the nearest rail. While stopped, the driver
- 9 shall listen and look in both directions along the track for an
- 10 approaching train and for signals indicating the approach of a
- 11 train, and shall not proceed until the driver can do so safely.

House Bill No. 4319 as amended April 29, 2015

- 1 After stopping as required in this subsection, and upon proceeding
- 2 when it is safe to do so, the driver of the vehicle shall cross
- 3 only in a gear of the vehicle that does not require changing gears
- 4 while traversing the crossing. The driver shall not shift gears
- 5 while crossing the track or tracks.
- 6 (2) A stop need not be made at a railroad track grade crossing
- 7 where a police officer or a traffic-control signal directs traffic
- 8 to proceed.
- 9 (3) A stop need not be made at an abandoned_INACTIVE railroad
- 10 track grade crossing. As used in this subsection, "abandoned
- 11 "INACTIVE railroad track" means a railroad track which THAT meets
- 12 all of the following requirements:
- 13 $\frac{(i)}{(i)}$ The track has been abandoned pursuant to federal law.
- 14 (i) $\frac{(ii)}{(ii)}$ The track has been covered or removed.
- 15 (ii) (iii)—All signs, signals, and other warning devices are
- 16 removed.
- 17 (4) A stop shall not be made at an industrial or spur line A
- 18 railroad grade crossing marked with a sign reading "exempt". Exempt
- 19 signs may be erected only by or with the consent of the state
- 20 transportation department after notice to and an opportunity to be
- 21 heard by all railroads THE PRIMARY RAILROAD operating over that
- 22 industrial or spur line. CROSSING.
- 23 (5) A person who violates this section is responsible for a
- 24 civil infraction.
