## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 4868

A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled "Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan," by amending section 9 (MCL 259.9), as amended by 2002 PA 35, and by adding section 98.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Taxi" means the moving of an aircraft under its own power
- 3 either on the ground or on the surface of the water, prior to
- 4 BEFORE the beginning of the take-off run and after the end of the
- 5 landing run.
- 6 (b) "Temporary commercial operations" means any commercial
- 7 operation conducted for a period not to exceed 120 days per
- 8 calendar year.

- 1 (c) "Ultralight" means an aircraft meeting requirements of 14
- 3 (D) "UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE" MEANS AN AIRCRAFT THAT IS
- 4 OPERATED WITHOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF DIRECT HUMAN INTERVENTION FROM
- 5 WITHIN OR ON THE AIRCRAFT.
- 6 (E) (d) "Vehicle" means any device in, upon, ON, or by which a
- 7 person or property is or may be transported, except an aircraft.
- 8 SEC. 98. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OPERATING AN UNMANNED AERIAL
- 9 VEHICLE SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) KNOWINGLY OPERATE THE UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE IN A MANNER
- 11 THAT OBSTRUCTS A PUBLIC SAFETY OPERATION.
- 12 (B) KNOWINGLY OPERATE THE UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE IN A MANNER
- 13 THAT INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATIONS OF A PUBLIC UTILITY, KEY
- 14 FACILITY, CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE.
- 15 (C) KNOWINGLY OPERATE THE UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE TO TRESPASS
- 16 WITHOUT LAWFUL AUTHORITY ON OR ABOVE PROPERTY OWNED OR UNDER THE
- 17 CONTROL OF ANY OTHER PERSON, OR TO SUBJECT ANOTHER PERSON TO
- 18 EAVESDROPPING OR SURVEILLANCE.
- 19 (D) KNOWINGLY OPERATE THE UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE FOR THE
- 20 PURPOSE OF COMMITTING AN ACT THAT IS PUNISHABLE AS A FELONY OR
- 21 MISDEMEANOR UNDER THE LAW OF THIS STATE.
- 22 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 23 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
- 24 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 25 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT THE ABILITY TO INVESTIGATE OR
- 26 TO ARREST, PROSECUTE, OR CONVICT AN INDIVIDUAL FOR ANY OTHER
- 27 VIOLATION OF A LAW OF THIS STATE.

- 1 (4) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO INDIVIDUALS OPERATING AN
- 2 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE FOR HOBBY OR RECREATION PURPOSES.
- 3 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 4 (A) "CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" MEANS A STATE CORRECTIONAL
- 5 FACILITY OR A JAIL AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 62 OF THE
- 6 CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.262, OR A FACILITY
- 7 OR INSTITUTION THAT IS MAINTAINED AND OPERATED BY A PRIVATE
- 8 CONTRACTOR UNDER SECTION 201 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953
- 9 PA 232, MCL 791.220I.
- 10 (B) "KEY FACILITY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 552C
- 11 OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.552C.
- 12 (C) "PUBLIC SAFETY OPERATION" MEANS AN OPERATION THAT INVOLVES
- 13 THE ACTIONS OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS WHILE THE
- 14 INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING HIS OR HER DUTIES:
- 15 (i) A POLICE OFFICER OF THIS STATE OR OF A POLITICAL
- 16 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A MOTOR
- 17 CARRIER OFFICER OR CAPITOL SECURITY OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 18 STATE POLICE.
- 19 (ii) A POLICE OFFICER OF A JUNIOR COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR
- 20 UNIVERSITY WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE JUNIOR
- 21 COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY TO ENFORCE STATE LAW AND THE RULES
- 22 AND ORDINANCES OF THE JUNIOR COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY.
- 23 (iii) A CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
- 24 RESOURCES OR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.
- 25 (iv) A CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
- 26 THE INTERIOR.
- 27 (v) A SHERIFF OR DEPUTY SHERIFF.

- 1 (vi) A CONSTABLE.
- 2 (vii) A PEACE OFFICER OF A DULY AUTHORIZED POLICE AGENCY OF
- 3 THE UNITED STATES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, AN AGENT OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.
- 5 (viii) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND
- 6 SECURITY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CUSTOMS AND BORDER
- 7 PROTECTION AND THE SECRET SERVICE.
- 8 (ix) A FIREFIGHTER.
- 9 (x) A STATE CORRECTIONAL OFFICER, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN
- 10 SECTION 2 OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' TRAINING ACT OF 1982, 1982
- 11 PA 415, MCL 791.502, OR A LOCAL CORRECTIONS OFFICER, AS THAT TERM
- 12 IS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE LOCAL CORRECTIONS OFFICERS TRAINING
- 13 ACT, 2003 PA 125, MCL 791.532.
- 14 (xi) A RAILROAD POLICE OFFICER, COMMISSIONED AS DESCRIBED IN
- 15 SECTION 385 OF THE RAILROAD CODE OF 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.385.
- 16 (xii) AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED UNDER SECTION 20950 OF THE PUBLIC
- 17 HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20950.
- 18 (xiii) AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN A SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATION
- 19 AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 50C OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE,
- 20 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.50C.
- 21 (xiv) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES
- 22 MILITARY AND IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES OR
- 23 A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OR THE DEFENSE FORCE AND IN ACTIVE
- 24 STATE SERVICE, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 105 OF THE
- 25 MICHIGAN MILITARY ACT, 1967 PA 150, MCL 32.505.
- 26 (D) "PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED
- 27 IN SECTION 10C OF 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.660C.

- (E) "PUBLIC UTILITY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1 1
- OF 1972 PA 299, MCL 460.111, BUT INCLUDING A MUNICIPALLY OWNED 2
- 3 UTILITY.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
