## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 5202

A bill to create a young adult commission; and to prescribe its powers and duties.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The young adult commission is created within the
- 2 department.
- 3 (2) The commission shall consist of 9 members between the ages
- 4 of 16 and 28, appointed as follows:
- 5 (a) Three members appointed by the governor, 1 of whom is a
- 6 disabled individual.
- 7 (b) Two members appointed by the speaker of the house of
- 8 representatives.
- 9 (c) Two members appointed by the senate majority leader.
- 10 (d) One member appointed by the minority leader of the senate.

- 1 (e) One member appointed by the minority leader of the house
- 2 of representatives.
- 3 (3) The members first appointed to the commission shall be
- 4 appointed within 120 days after the effective date of this act.
- 5 (4) Members of the commission shall serve for terms of 2 years
- 6 or until a successor is appointed, whichever is later.
- 7 (5) A vacancy on the commission shall be filled in the same
- 8 manner as the original appointment.
- 9 (6) The first meeting of the commission shall be called by the
- 10 governor. At the first meeting, the commission shall elect from
- 11 among its members a chairperson and other officers as it considers
- 12 necessary or appropriate. After the first meeting, the commission
- 13 shall meet quarterly, or more frequently at the call of the
- 14 chairperson or if requested by 2 or more members.
- 15 (7) A majority of the members of the commission constitute a
- 16 quorum for the transaction of business at a meeting of the
- 17 commission. A majority of the members present and serving are
- 18 required for official action of the commission.
- 19 (8) The business that the commission may perform shall be
- 20 conducted at a public meeting of the commission held in compliance
- 21 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 22 (9) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 23 retained by the commission in the performance of an official
- 24 function is subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442,
- 25 MCL 15.231 to 15.246.
- 26 (10) Members of the commission shall serve without
- 27 compensation.

- 1 (11) The commission shall do each of the following:
- 2 (a) Recognize contributions of youths in this state.
- 3 (b) Hold forums to give youths in this state a voice and share
- 4 information with the legislative, executive, and judicial branches.
- 5 (c) Submit an annual report to the governor and the
- 6 legislature on youth issues.
- 7 (d) Work in collaboration with existing state agencies to
- 8 develop a comprehensive social media campaign to reach youths and
- 9 expand youths' opportunities to communicate with state government.
- 10 (e) Work in collaboration with existing state agencies to
- 11 increase retention of youths in this state and make this state a
- 12 more attractive place for youths to live and work.
- 13 (f) Make recommendations on pending legislation.
- 14 (g) Propose solutions for current and emerging challenges for
- 15 youths in this state.
- Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 17 (a) "Commission" means the young adult commission created in
- **18** section 1.
- 19 (b) "Department" means the department of talent and economic
- 20 development.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 22 date it is enacted into law.
