SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4898

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 287.331), as amended by 1997 PA 7.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Adoption" means a transfer of ownership, with or without
- 3 remuneration, of a dog, cat, or ferret from an animal control
- 4 shelter or animal protection shelter to an individual for the
- 5 purpose of being a companion animal for that individual. As used in
- 6 this subdivision, a companion animal includes but is not limited to
- 7 a dog that is used for hunting or as a guard dog.
- 8 (b) "Alteration" means a professional sterilization procedure
- 9 performed by a veterinarian that renders a dog, cat, or ferret

- 1 incapable of reproducing.
- 2 (c) "Altered", in reference to a dog, cat, or ferret, means
- 3 having undergone alteration.
- 4 (d) "Animal" means a mammal except livestock as **THAT TERM IS**
- 5 defined in **SECTION 1 OF** 1937 PA 284, MCL 287.121, to 287.131, and
- 6 rodents.
- 7 (e) "Animal control shelter" means a facility operated by a
- 8 municipality for the impoundment and care of animals that are found
- 9 in the streets or at large, animals that are otherwise held due to
- 10 the violation of a municipal ordinance or state law, or animals
- 11 that are surrendered to the animal control shelter.
- 12 (f) "Animal protection shelter" means a facility operated by a
- 13 person, humane society, society for the prevention of cruelty to
- 14 animals, or any other nonprofit organization, OR OTHER PERSON for
- 15 the care of homeless animals.
- 16 (G) "ANIMAL WELFARE" MEANS THE STANDARDS OF CARE AND TREATMENT
- 17 FOR ANIMALS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, HUSBANDRY, HOUSING,
- 18 SANITATION, NUTRITION, AND VETERINARY CARE, TO ENSURE THEIR
- 19 PHYSICAL HEALTH AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING.
- 20 (H) (g) "Cat" means a domestic cat of any age of the species
- 21 felis FELIS catus.
- 22 (I) "COMMISSION" MEANS THE ANIMAL WELFARE COMMISSION CREATED
- 23 IN SECTION 11.
- 24 (J) (h) "Department" means the state department of agriculture
- 25 AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT.
- 26 (K) (i) "Director" means the director of the department or his
- 27 or her authorized representative.

- 1 (1) $\frac{(j)}{(j)}$ "Dog" means a domestic dog of any age of the species
- 2 canis CANIS familiaris.
- 3 (M) (k) "Ferret" means an animal of any age of the species
- 4 mustela MUSTELA furo.
- 5 (N) (l)—"Health certificate" means a certificate in a form
- 6 prescribed by the department in which a veterinarian attests to the
- 7 age, sex, breed, and description of an animal, and to the fact
- 8 that, at the time of preparation of the certificate, the
- 9 veterinarian examined the animal and found the animal free from
- 10 visual evidence of communicable disease.
- 11 (0) (m) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or
- 12 township.
- (P) (n) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 14 corporation, association, governmental entity, or other legal
- 15 entity.
- 16 (Q) (o) "Pet shop" means a place where animals are sold or
- 17 offered for sale, exchange, or transfer.
- 18 (R) (p) "Veterinarian" means a person AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 19 licensed to practice veterinary medicine under article 15 of the
- 20 public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 to 333.18838.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 22 unless Senate Bill No. 339 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into
- 23 law.
