

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 113

A bill to amend 1921 PA 137, entitled

"An act authorizing counties of this state to contract with agencies, institutions, and hospitals licensed by the department of consumer and industry services for the aid, care, support, maintenance, treatment, cure, or relief of children,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 722.501), as amended by 1996 PA 411.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. A county board of commissioners may enter into an
2 agreement or agreements for a period not exceeding 1 year with any
3 agency, institution, or hospital, or agencies, institutions, or
4 hospitals ~~which~~ **THAT** have been and are for the current year
5 licensed by the department of ~~consumer and industry services~~
6 **LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS** to receive aid, care for, support,
7 maintain, treat, cure, or relieve in or by the agency, institution,
8 or hospital, any poor, sick, distressed, abandoned, **OR** needy 7

1 **CHILDREN OR YOUTH, or ~~crippled child or children~~ OR YOUTH WITH**
2 **SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS,** residing within the county who may be
3 referred to ~~such~~**THE** agency, institution, or hospital by a judge of
4 the family division of circuit court for the county in accordance
5 with the provisions of this act, whether the aid, care, support,
6 maintenance, treatment, cure, or relief is furnished wholly or in
7 part by ~~such~~**THE** agency, institution, or hospital. The proper
8 charges under the contract or contracts shall be audited and paid
9 from time to time by the board of auditors, or by the county board
10 of commissioners of the county in counties not having a board of
11 auditors. ~~However, a~~**A** county board of commissioners, before
12 entering into a contract under this section shall fix the maximum
13 amount to be expended for the purposes described in this section
14 during any 1 year, which shall be raised, levied, and collected as
15 part of the general expense of the county.

16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
17 unless House Bill No. 4205 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into
18 law.
