HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 501

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 302a (MCL 257.302a), as amended by 2006 PA 298.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 302a. (1) Except as otherwise provided by this act, a
- 2 nonresident operator of a motor vehicle who is the holder of a
- 3 VALID license to operate a motor vehicle in the ISSUED BY A country
- 4 in which he or she resides OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES is not
- 5 required to obtain a license to operate a passenger vehicle within
- 6 IN this state if he or she does not receive compensation for such
- 7 operation AND WOULD OTHERWISE SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION
- 8 307(1), EXCEPT FOR THE VERIFICATION OF RESIDENCY. This subsection
- 9 does not apply unless all of the following conditions have been
- 10 satisfied:

- 1 (a) The secretary of state determines that the standards of
- 2 the other country for licensing operators correspond substantially
- 3 to those of this state and that the other country extends the same
- 4 privileges to persons licensed to operate vehicles by this
- 5 state. THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE POSSESSION A VALID
- 6 LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A COUNTRY OTHER THAN
- 7 THE UNITED STATES.
- 8 (b) The secretary of state and the other country have
- 9 exchanged letters confirming the reciprocal extension of privileges
- 10 to operate vehicles. IF NO ENGLISH TRANSLATION APPEARS ON THE FRONT
- 11 OR BACK OF THE LICENSE, THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE
- 12 POSSESSION AN INTERNATIONAL DRIVING PERMIT OR A COMPARABLE ENGLISH
- 13 TRANSLATION OF HIS OR HER VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 14 (C) THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE POSSESSION A
- 15 VALID PASSPORT OR A VALID VISA THAT WAS ISSUED BY THE COUNTRY IN
- 16 WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL'S LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WAS
- 17 ISSUED.
- 18 (2) A VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A
- 19 COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES THAT IS ENHANCED OR OTHERWISE
- 20 SECURED TO COMPLY WITH THE WESTERN HEMISPHERE TRAVEL INITIATIVE
- 21 SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1).
- 22 (3) (2)—The secretary of state shall publish on its public
- 23 internet site a list of the countries for which reciprocal
- 24 operating privileges have been extended and withdrawn. If any
- 25 changes are made, a revised list shall be mailed to the courts,
- 26 prosecuting attorneys, and law enforcement agencies of this
- 27 state. ESTABLISH A UNIQUE DRIVER RECORD FOR AN INDIVIDUAL UPON

- 1 RECEIPT OF AN ABSTRACT OF CONVICTION FOR ANY OFFENSE COMMITTED IN
- 2 VIOLATION OF THIS ACT BY THAT INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OPERATING A MOTOR
- 3 VEHICLE IN THIS STATE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1). THE OPERATION
- 4 OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO POSSESSES A
- 5 VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A COUNTRY OTHER
- 6 THAN THE UNITED STATES IS SUBJECT TO THIS ACT.
- 7 (4) AN INDIVIDUAL FOR WHOM A UNIQUE DRIVER RECORD HAS BEEN
- 8 CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) IS SUBJECT TO ALL FEES, FINES,
- 9 RESTRICTIONS, AND ENFORCEMENT AS IF HE OR SHE WERE LICENSED UNDER
- 10 THIS ACT.
- 11 (5) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 12 FROM ENTERING INTO A RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AND EXCHANGING LETTERS
- 13 CONFIRMING THE EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES TO OPERATE VEHICLES WITH
- 14 ANOTHER COUNTRY.
- 15 (6) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE A LIST
- 16 OF THE COUNTRIES WITH WHICH IT HAS ENTERED INTO A RECIPROCAL
- 17 AGREEMENT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (5).
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
