SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 555

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending section 210 (MCL 339.210).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 210. (1) The department, on its own behalf and on behalf
- 2 of a board created under this act, may contract with persons or
- 3 agencies who are not employees or agencies of the department to
- 4 implement this act and to fulfill the responsibilities of the
- 5 department or a board.
- 6 (2) UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO AN
- 7 AGREEMENT WITH AN ENTITY THAT IS NOT AN AGENCY OF A STATE OR THE
- 8 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC CONTINUING EDUCATION
- 9 TRACKING SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES AN ELECTRONIC RECORD OF THE

- CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES, CLASSES, OR PROGRAMS COMPLETED BY ALL 1
- 2 OF THE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER THIS ACT,
- EXCEPT FOR THOSE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 7 OR 3
- ARTICLE 25. ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM
- 5 PROVIDED BY AN AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:
- (A) ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING PROVIDED BY THE SYSTEM
- 7 MUST ACCURATELY REFLECT THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER
- THIS ACT AND RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT. 8
- (B) A CONFIRMATION OF COMPLETION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION 9
- REQUIREMENTS GENERATED BY THE SYSTEM IS CONSIDERED VERIFICATION OF 10
- 11 COMPLETION OF THOSE REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE OR
- 12 REGISTRATION AND FOR PURPOSES OF ANY AUDIT OF LICENSEES OR
- REGISTRANTS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT. 13
- (C) THE SYSTEM MUST PROVIDE ACCESS TO CONTINUING EDUCATION 14
- INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER 15
- THIS ACT TO THE INDIVIDUAL, TO THE APPROPRIATE BOARD FOR THE 16
- INDIVIDUAL'S OCCUPATION, AND TO THE DEPARTMENT. 17
- (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE ANY RULES IT CONSIDERS 18
- 19 APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER SUBSECTION (2).
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
