SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5338

A bill to amend 1994 PA 39, entitled "Veteran right to employment services act," by amending section 2 (MCL 35.1092).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Armed forces" means the army, air force, navy, marine
- 3 corps, coast guard, or other military force designated by congress
- 4 as a part of the armed forces of the United States.
- 5 (A) (b)—"Employment services" means referrals to employers,
- 6 supportive services, or assistance in finding employment training.
- 7 (B) (c)—"Job training services" means any program that
- 8 provides training or training services to eligible applicants.
- 9 (C) (d) "Veteran" means any of the following:

- 1 a period of more than 180 days and separated from the armed forces
- 2 in a manner other than a dishonorable discharge.
- 3 (ii) A person discharged or released from active duty because
- 4 of a service related disability.
- 5 (iii) A member of a reserve branch of the armed forces at the
- 6 time he or she was ordered to active duty pursuant to section
- 7 672(a), (d), or (g), or section 673 or 673b of title 10 of the
- 8 United States Code, 10 U.S.C. 672, 673, and 673b, who served on
- 9 active duty during a period of war, or in a campaign or expedition
- 10 for which a campaign badge is authorized, and was released from
- 11 active duty in a manner other than a dishonorable discharge.AN
- 12 INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (i) IS A VETERAN AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1 OF 1965 PA 190, MCL
- 14 35.61.
- 15 (ii) SERVED AT LEAST 180 DAYS OF ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED
- 16 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES OR HAS A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY
- 17 AS A RESULT OF SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless House Bill No. 5332 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into
- 22 law.
