SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5877

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding sections 17760 and 17760a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 17760. (1) A PHARMACY THAT IS OWNED AND OPERATED BY A
- 2 HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 17 MAY OPERATE AN AUTOMATED DEVICE
- 3 AT A LOCATION THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH THE HOSPITAL BUT THAT IS NOT
- 4 LOCATED AT THE SAME PHYSICAL ADDRESS AS THE PHARMACY. A PHARMACY
- 5 THAT OPERATES AN AUTOMATED DEVICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOTIFY
- 6 THE DEPARTMENT OF THE AUTOMATED DEVICE'S LOCATION.
- 7 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION AND SECTION 17760A, "AUTOMATED
- 8 DEVICE" MEANS A MECHANICAL SYSTEM THAT PERFORMS AN OPERATION OR

- 1 ACTIVITY, OTHER THAN COMPOUNDING OR ADMINISTRATION, RELATING TO THE
- 2 STORAGE, PACKAGING, DISPENSING, DISTRIBUTION, OR DELIVERY OF A DRUG
- 3 AND THAT COLLECTS, CONTROLS, AND MAINTAINS TRANSACTION INFORMATION.
- 4 AN AUTOMATED DEVICE IS NOT A PHARMACY.
- SEC. 17760A. AN AUTOMATED DEVICE THAT IS OPERATED UNDER 5
- SECTION 17760 SHALL BE UNDER THE CONTROL AND SUPERVISION OF THE
- PHARMACIST IN CHARGE FOR THE PHARMACY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 17760. 7
- THE PHARMACIST IN CHARGE FOR THE PHARMACY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 8
- 17760 MAY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DELEGATION AND 9
- 10 SUPERVISION IN THIS ARTICLE, DELEGATE THE STOCKING OF THE AUTOMATED
- 11 DEVICE, THE REMOVAL OF MEDICATION FROM THE AUTOMATED DEVICE, THE
- 12 MAINTENANCE OF THE AUTOMATED DEVICE, AND OTHER TASKS RELATED TO THE
- 13 OPERATION OF THE AUTOMATED DEVICE, BUT HE OR SHE IS NOT REQUIRED TO
- 14 BE IMMEDIATELY PHYSICALLY PRESENT TO SUPERVISE A DELEGATED TASK.
- 15 THE OPERATION OF THE AUTOMATED DEVICE SHALL BE LIMITED TO LICENSED
- HEALTH PROFESSIONALS. 16
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
