## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1044

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 10 (MCL 722.120), as amended by 2006 PA 206.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10. (1) The department may investigate and examine
- 2 conditions of a child care organization in which a licensee
- 3 receives, maintains, or places out children, and may investigate
- 4 and examine the books and records of the licensee. The licensee
- 5 shall admit members of the department and furnish all reasonable
- 6 facilities for thorough examination of its books, records, and
- 7 reports. The department, of community health, the bureau of fire
- 8 services, or local authorities, in carrying out the provisions of

- 1 this act, may visit a child care organization to advise in matters
- 2 affecting the health or fire protection of children.
- 3 (2) A licensee shall keep the records the department
- 4 prescribes regarding each child in its control and care and shall
- 5 report to the department, when requested, the facts the department
- 6 requires with reference to the children upon forms furnished by the
- 7 department. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection AND
- 8 SUBSECTION (3), records regarding children and facts compiled about
- 9 children and their parents and relatives are confidential and
- 10 disclosure of this information shall be properly safeguarded by the
- 11 child care organization, the department, and any other entity in
- 12 possession of the information. Records that are confidential under
- 13 this section are available to both of the following:
- 14 (a) A standing or select committee or appropriations
- 15 subcommittee of either house of the legislature having jurisdiction
- 16 over protective services matters for children, pursuant ACCORDING
- 17 to section 7 of the child protection law, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.627.
- 18 (b) The children's ombudsman established in section 3 of the
- 19 children's ombudsman act, 1994 PA 204, MCL 722.923.
- 20 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2), AND SECTIONS 5 AND 7(2)(R)
- 21 AND 7(3) OF THE CHILD PROTECTION LAW, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.625 AND
- 22 722.627, INFORMATION OR RECORDS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 23 OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS MAY BE SHARED
- 24 TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER FUNCTIONING OF THE
- 25 DEPARTMENT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS IN
- 26 ADMINISTERING CHILD WELFARE OR CHILD CARE LICENSING UNDER THIS ACT
- 27 OR IN AN INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED UNDER SECTION 43B OF THE SOCIAL

- WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.43B. INFORMATION OR RECORDS 1
- 2 SHARED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE RELEASED BY THE
- DEPARTMENT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS 3
- UNLESS OTHERWISE PERMITTED UNDER THIS ACT OR OTHER STATE OR FEDERAL
- LAW. NEITHER THE DEPARTMENT NOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND 5
- REGULATORY AFFAIRS SHALL RELEASE OR OPEN FOR INSPECTION ANY
- DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR RECORD AUTHORED BY OR OBTAINED FROM ANOTHER 7
- AGENCY OR ORGANIZATION UNLESS 1 OF THE CONDITIONS OF SECTION 7(10) 8
- OF THE CHILD PROTECTION LAW, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.627, APPLIES. 9
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
