SENATE BILL NO. 1070

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 48714a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 48714A. (1) BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2019, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL
- 2 NOT ACT AS A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE ON THE INLAND WATERS OF THIS
- 3 STATE UNLESS THAT INDIVIDUAL POSSESSES BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 5 (B) A VALID FISHING LICENSE.
- 6 (2) TO OBTAIN A LICENSE TO ACT AS A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE,
- 7 AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FEE DESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 8 48714B AND AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT. THE APPLICATION SHALL
- 9 BE IN A FORM AND FORMAT DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE

- 1 DEPARTMENT SHALL ONLY GRANT A LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT DETERMINES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN FIRST
- 4 AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION ISSUED BY THE AMERICAN RED
- 5 CROSS, THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A COMPARABLE ORGANIZATION
- 6 AS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 7 (B) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS COVERED BY COMMERCIAL GENERAL
- 8 LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH LIMITS OF NOT LESS THAN \$300,000.00 PER
- 9 CLAIM AND \$1,000,000.00 AGGREGATE, FOR THE PERIOD THAT THE LICENSE
- 10 IS VALID.
- 11 (C) THE PERSON HAS A VALID, LAWFULLY OBTAINED MICHIGAN DRIVER
- 12 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL
- 13 257.1 TO 257.923, AN OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD
- 14 ISSUED UNDER 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 TO 28.300, OR A SPORTCARD
- 15 ISSUED UNDER SECTION 43522.
- 16 (D) UNTIL FEBRUARY 29, 2020, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT BEEN
- 17 CONVICTED OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE PAST 2 YEARS:
- 18 (i) A VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 435, OR
- 19 445.
- 20 (ii) A VIOLATION OF AN ORDER OR INTERIM ORDER ISSUED UNDER
- 21 THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 435, OR 445.
- 22 (iii) ANY FELONY.
- 23 (iv) A VIOLATION OF A LAW OF A PARTICIPATING STATE
- 24 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN
- 25 SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (iii).
- 26 (E) BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2020, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT BEEN
- 27 CONVICTED OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE PAST 3 YEARS:

- 1 (i) A VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 435, OR
- 2 445.
- 3 (ii) A VIOLATION OF AN ORDER OR INTERIM ORDER ISSUED UNDER
- 4 THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 435, OR 445.
- 5 (iii) ANY FELONY.
- 6 (iv) A VIOLATION OF A LAW OF A PARTICIPATING STATE
- 7 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN
- 8 SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (iii).
- 9 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT ACT AS A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE
- 10 ON COMMERCIAL FORESTLAND.
- 11 (4) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS VALID FOR 3 YEARS
- 12 AFTER THE DATE IT IS ISSUED. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, FOR EACH YEAR
- 13 THAT A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION IS VALID, INCLUDE A PUBLIC
- 14 BOATING ACCESS ENTRY PASS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 78105(3) WITH ANY
- 15 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE A
- 16 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION, AFTER NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR
- 17 HEARING PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969
- 18 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO 24.328, FOR EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:
- 19 (A) THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT AN INDIVIDUAL IS NOT
- 20 ELIGIBLE TO HOLD A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 21 (B) THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION UNDER THIS
- 22 SECTION.
- 23 (5) A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE SHALL FILE MONTHLY REPORTS TO
- 24 THE DEPARTMENT, IN A FORMAT DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THAT
- 25 CONTAIN INFORMATION RELATED TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 26 (A) THE COUNTIES OF THIS STATE WHERE THE INDIVIDUAL ACTED AS A
- 27 COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE.

- 1 (B) THE SPECIES OF FISH FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL ACTED AS A
- 2 COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE.
- 3 (C) THE NUMBER OF CLIENTS THAT THE COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE
- 4 HAD FOR EACH FISHING TRIP AND THE NUMBER OF HOURS FISHED FOR EACH
- 5 FISHING TRIP.
- 6 (D) THE NUMBER OF FISH CAUGHT AND RELEASED AND THE NUMBER OF
- 7 FISH HARVESTED BY THE CLIENTS OF THE COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE.
- 8 (E) THE BODIES OF WATER WHERE THE INDIVIDUAL ACTED AS A
- 9 COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE.
- 10 (F) ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES
- 11 REGARDING THE FISHING ACTIVITY OR BIOLOGICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE
- 12 FISH CAUGHT AND RELEASED OR HARVESTED.
- 13 (G) FOR ANY MONTH THAT THE GUIDE DID NOT ACT AS A COMMERCIAL
- 14 FISHING GUIDE, A REPORT STATING THAT THE INDIVIDUAL DID NOT ACT AS
- 15 A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE DURING THAT MONTH.
- 16 (6) IF AN INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO FILE A MONTHLY REPORT UNDER
- 17 SUBSECTION (5) AND THAT REPORT REMAINS UNFILED FOR MORE THAN 90
- 18 DAYS AFTER THE DATE IT IS DUE, THE INDIVIDUAL IS SUBJECT TO THE
- 19 FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) FOR THE FIRST VIOLATION, A \$100.00 CIVIL FINE.
- 21 (B) FOR THE SECOND VIOLATION, A \$200.00 CIVIL FINE.
- 22 (C) FOR A THIRD VIOLATION, A \$500.00 CIVIL FINE.
- 23 (D) FOR A FOURTH VIOLATION, AFTER NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY
- 24 FOR HEARING PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969,
- 25 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO 24.328, A REVOCATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S
- 26 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 27 (7) INFORMATION SUBMITTED IN REPORTS UNDER SUBSECTION (5) IS

- 1 CONFIDENTIAL AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF
- 2 INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
- 3 (8) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY POST ON ITS WEBSITE ALL OF
- 4 THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2)
- 6 IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 7 (B) THE NUMBER OF LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE
- 8 PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 9 (C) A LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE VALID LICENSES UNDER THIS
- 10 SECTION.
- 11 (9) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL CARRY HIS OR HER COMMERCIAL FISHING
- 12 GUIDE LICENSE AND SHALL EXHIBIT THE LICENSE UPON THE DEMAND OF A
- 13 CONSERVATION OFFICER, A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A TRIBAL
- 14 CONSERVATION OFFICER, OR THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF ANY LAND WHERE
- 15 THE INDIVIDUAL IS ACTING AS A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE.
- 16 (10) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ACTS AS A COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE
- 17 WITHOUT A VALID PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A
- 18 CIVIL FINE OF \$2,000.00. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ACTS AS A COMMERCIAL
- 19 FISHING GUIDE WITHOUT A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION A
- 20 SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT TIME IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF \$4,000.00.
- 21 A CIVIL FINE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION OR SUBSECTION (6)
- 22 SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE GAME AND FISH PROTECTION ACCOUNT
- 23 ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 2010.
- 24 (11) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION TO THE
- 25 DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE
- 26 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT LESS
- 27 THAN \$1,000.00 OR MORE THAN \$2,500.00, OR BOTH, AND THE COSTS OF

- 1 PROSECUTION.
- 2 (12) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 3 (A) "COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, FOR A
- 4 FEE OR OTHER CONSIDERATION, PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER
- 5 INDIVIDUAL IN PURSUING, CAPTURING, CATCHING, KILLING, TAKING, OR
- 6 ATTEMPTING TO TAKE FISH. COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 7 AN EMPLOYEE OR MEMBER OF AN ORGANIZATION CONDUCTING A NOT-FOR-
- 8 PROFIT ACTIVITY TO RECRUIT, RETAIN, OR PROMOTE FISHING, WHILE
- 9 PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN TAKING FISH DURING
- 10 THAT ACTIVITY, OR THE OWNER OF PRIVATE LAND WHILE PROVIDING
- 11 ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN PURSUING, CAPTURING, CATCHING,
- 12 KILLING, TAKING, OR ATTEMPTING TO TAKE FISH ON THAT PRIVATE LAND.
- 13 (B) "CONSIDERATION OF VALUE" MEANS AN ECONOMIC BENEFIT,
- 14 INDUCEMENT, RIGHT, OR PROFIT, INCLUDING MONETARY PAYMENT ACCRUING
- 15 TO AN INDIVIDUAL OR PERSON. CONSIDERATION OF VALUE DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 16 A VOLUNTARY SHARING OF THE ACTUAL EXPENSES OF THE GUIDING ACTIVITY,
- 17 BY MONETARY CONTRIBUTION OR DONATION OF FUEL, FOOD, BEVERAGE, OR
- 18 OTHER SUPPLIES.
- 19 (C) "PARTICIPATING STATE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 20 SECTION 1615.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 24 unless all of the following bills of the 98th Legislature are
- 25 enacted into law:
