SENATE BILL NO. 1072

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 43528c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 43528C. (1) BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2019, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL
- 2 NOT ACT AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE IN THIS STATE UNLESS THAT
- 3 INDIVIDUAL POSSESSES BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 5 (B) A VALID BASE LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SECTION 43523A.
- 6 (2) TO OBTAIN A LICENSE TO ACT AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE,
- 7 AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FEE DESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 8 43528D AND AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT. THE APPLICATION SHALL
- 9 BE IN A FORM AND FORMAT DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE

- 1 DEPARTMENT SHALL ONLY GRANT A LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT DETERMINES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN FIRST
- 4 AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION ISSUED BY THE AMERICAN RED
- 5 CROSS, THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A COMPARABLE ORGANIZATION
- 6 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 7 (B) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS COVERED BY COMMERCIAL GENERAL
- 8 LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH LIMITS OF NOT LESS THAN \$300,000.00 PER
- 9 CLAIM AND \$1,000,000.00 AGGREGATE, FOR THE PERIOD THAT THE LICENSE
- 10 IS VALID.
- 11 (C) THE PERSON HAS A VALID, LAWFULLY OBTAINED MICHIGAN DRIVER
- 12 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL
- 13 257.1 TO 257.923, AN OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD
- 14 ISSUED UNDER 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 TO 28.300, OR A SPORTCARD
- 15 ISSUED UNDER SECTION 43522.
- 16 (D) UNTIL FEBRUARY 29, 2020, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT BEEN
- 17 CONVICTED OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE PAST 2 YEARS:
- 18 (i) A VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 445, OR
- 19 487.
- 20 (ii) A VIOLATION OF AN ORDER OR INTERIM ORDER ISSUED UNDER
- 21 THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 445, OR 487.
- 22 (iii) ANY FELONY.
- 23 (iv) A VIOLATION OF A LAW OF A PARTICIPATING STATE
- 24 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN
- 25 SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (iii).
- 26 (E) BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2020, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT BEEN
- 27 CONVICTED OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE PAST 3 YEARS:

- 1 (i) A VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 445, OR
- 2 487.
- 3 (ii) A VIOLATION OF AN ORDER OR INTERIM ORDER ISSUED UNDER
- 4 THIS PART OR PART 401, 411, 413, 445, OR 487.
- 5 (iii) ANY FELONY.
- 6 (iv) A VIOLATION OF A LAW OF A PARTICIPATING STATE
- 7 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN
- 8 SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (iii).
- 9 (F) THE INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE A LICENSE FOR THE
- 10 GAME SPECIES FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL IS ACTING AS A COMMERCIAL
- 11 HUNTING GUIDE.
- 12 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT ACT AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE
- 13 ON COMMERCIAL FORESTLAND.
- 14 (4) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS VALID FOR 3 YEARS
- 15 AFTER THE DATE IT IS ISSUED. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE A LICENSE
- 16 UNDER THIS SECTION, AFTER NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING
- 17 PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 18 MCL 24.201 TO 24.328, FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:
- 19 (A) THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT
- 20 ELIGIBLE TO HOLD A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 21 (B) THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION UNDER THIS
- 22 SECTION.
- 23 (C) THE INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT UNDER
- 24 SUBSECTION (5), AND THAT REPORT REMAINS UNFILED FOR MORE THAN 90
- 25 DAYS AFTER IT IS DUE.
- 26 (5) A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE SHALL FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT
- 27 WITH THE DEPARTMENT, IN A FORMAT DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THAT

- 1 CONTAINS INFORMATION RELATED TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) THE COUNTIES OF THIS STATE WHERE THE INDIVIDUAL ACTED AS A
- 3 COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE.
- 4 (B) THE SPECIES OF GAME FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL ACTED AS A
- 5 COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE.
- 6 (C) THE NUMBER OF CLIENTS THAT THE COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE
- 7 HAD DURING THE YEAR.
- 8 (D) THE NUMBER OF GAME ANIMALS HARVESTED BY THE CLIENTS OF THE
- 9 COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE.
- 10 (E) ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES
- 11 REGARDING THE BIOLOGICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE GAME ANIMALS
- 12 HARVESTED.
- 13 (6) INFORMATION SUBMITTED IN A REPORT UNDER SUBSECTION (5) IS
- 14 CONFIDENTIAL AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF
- 15 INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
- 16 (7) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY POST ON ITS WEBSITE ALL OF
- 17 THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2)
- 19 IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 20 (B) THE NUMBER OF LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE
- 21 PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 22 (C) A LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE VALID LICENSES UNDER THIS
- 23 SECTION.
- 24 (8) A INDIVIDUAL SHALL CARRY HIS OR HER COMMERCIAL HUNTING
- 25 GUIDE LICENSE AND SHALL EXHIBIT THE LICENSE UPON THE DEMAND OF A
- 26 CONSERVATION OFFICER, A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A TRIBAL
- 27 CONSERVATION OFFICER, OR THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF ANY LAND WHERE

- 1 THE INDIVIDUAL IS ACTING AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE.
- 2 (9) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ACTS AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE
- 3 WITHOUT A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION OR WHO ACTS AS A
- 4 COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE ON COMMERCIAL FORESTLAND IS SUBJECT TO A
- 5 CIVIL FINE OF \$2,000.00. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ACTS AS A COMMERCIAL
- 6 HUNTING GUIDE WITHOUT A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION OR
- 7 WHO ACTS AS A COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE ON COMMERCIAL FORESTLAND A
- 8 SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT TIME IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF \$4,000.00.
- 9 A CIVIL FINE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN
- 10 THE GAME AND FISH PROTECTION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 2010.
- 11 (10) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION TO THE
- 12 DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE
- 13 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT LESS
- 14 THAN \$1,000.00 OR MORE THAN \$2,500.00, OR BOTH, AND THE COSTS OF
- 15 PROSECUTION.
- 16 (11) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 17 (A) "COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, FOR A
- 18 FEE OR OTHER CONSIDERATION OF VALUE, PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER
- 19 INDIVIDUAL IN HUNTING GAME. COMMERCIAL HUNTING GUIDE DOES NOT
- 20 INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (i) THE OWNER OF PRIVATE LAND WHILE PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO
- 22 ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN PURSUING, CAPTURING, CATCHING, KILLING,
- 23 TAKING, OR ATTEMPTING TO TAKE GAME ON THAT PRIVATE LAND.
- 24 (ii) THE OWNER, EMPLOYEE, OR MEMBER OF A GAME BIRD HUNTING
- 25 PRESERVE LICENSED UNDER PART 417, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE, WHILE
- 26 PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN PURSUING, CAPTURING,
- 27 CATCHING, KILLING, TAKING, OR ATTEMPTING TO TAKE GAME BIRDS

- 1 AUTHORIZED TO BE HUNTED ON THAT GAME BIRD HUNTING PRESERVE.
- 2 (iii) AN INDIVIDUAL, BUSINESS, AGENCY, OR NONPROFIT
- 3 ORGANIZATION ISSUED A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE DAMAGE
- 4 OR NUISANCE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES, WHILE PROVIDING THOSE DAMAGE
- 5 OR NUISANCE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES.
- 6 (iv) AN EMPLOYEE OR MEMBER OF AN ORGANIZATION CONDUCTING A
- 7 NOT-FOR-PROFIT EVENT TO RECRUIT, RETAIN, OR PROMOTE HUNTING, WHILE
- 8 PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN HUNTING GAME DURING
- 9 THAT EVENT.
- 10 (B) "CONSIDERATION OF VALUE" MEANS AN ECONOMIC BENEFIT,
- 11 INDUCEMENT, RIGHT, OR PROFIT, INCLUDING MONETARY PAYMENT ACCRUING
- 12 TO AN INDIVIDUAL OR PERSON. CONSIDERATION OF VALUE DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 13 A VOLUNTARY SHARING OF THE ACTUAL EXPENSES OF THE GUIDING ACTIVITY
- 14 BY MONETARY CONTRIBUTION OR DONATION OF FUEL, FOOD, BEVERAGES, OR
- 15 OTHER SUPPLIES.
- 16 (C) "PARTICIPATING STATE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 17 SECTION 1615.
- 18 (D) "PRIVATELY OWNED CERVID RANCH" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED
- 19 IN SECTION 6 OF THE ANIMAL INDUSTRY ACT, 1988 PA 466, MCL 287.706.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 22 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 23 unless all of the following bills of the 98th Legislature are
- 24 enacted into law:
