SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4013

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 223 (MCL 257.223), as amended by 2007 PA 143.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 223. (1) A registration certificate shall at all times be
- 2 carried in the vehicle to which it refers or shall be carried by OR
- 3 ELECTRONICALLY ACCESSIBLE TO the person driving or in control of
- 4 the vehicle, who shall display A PAPER OR ELECTRONIC COPY OF the
- 5 registration certificate upon demand of a police officer.
- 6 (2) IF A PERSON DISPLAYS AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF HIS OR HER
- 7 REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE USING AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE, THE POLICE
- 8 OFFICER SHALL ONLY VIEW THE ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE REGISTRATION
- 9 CERTIFICATE AND SHALL NOT MANIPULATE THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE TO VIEW

- ANY OTHER INFORMATION ON THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE. A PERSON WHO 1
- 2 DISPLAYS AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF HIS OR HER REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE
- USING AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT 3
- BE PRESUMED TO HAVE CONSENTED TO A SEARCH OF THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE.
- A POLICE OFFICER MAY REQUIRE THE PERSON TO ELECTRONICALLY FORWARD 5
- THE ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE TO A SPECIFIED
- LOCATION PROVIDED BY THE POLICE OFFICER. THE POLICE OFFICER MAY 7
- THEN VIEW THE ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IN A 8
- SETTING IN WHICH IT IS SAFE FOR THE OFFICER TO VERIFY THAT THE 9
- INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE REGISTRATION 10
- 11 CERTIFICATE IS VALID AND ACCURATE. THIS STATE, A LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 12 AGENCY, OR AN EMPLOYEE OF THIS STATE OR A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IS
- NOT LIABLE FOR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT 13
- OCCURS AS A RESULT OF A POLICE OFFICER'S VIEWING AN ELECTRONIC COPY 14
- OF A REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IN THE MANNER PROVIDED IN THIS 15
- SECTION, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE POLICE OFFICER OR THE OWNER OR 16
- OPERATOR OF THE VEHICLE WAS IN POSSESSION OF THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE 17
- AT THE TIME THE DAMAGE OR LOSS OCCURRED. 18
- 19 (3) A DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH OF A VALID REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE
- 20 SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1).
- 21 (4) $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 22 a civil infraction.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
