SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4067

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 17001 and 17501 (MCL 333.17001 and 333.17501), as amended by 2016 PA 379, and by adding sections 17011a and 17511a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17001. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Academic institution" means either of the following:
- 3 (i) A medical school approved by the board.
- $\mathbf{4}$ (ii) A hospital licensed under article 17 that meets all of
- 5 the following requirements:
- 6 (A) Was the sole sponsor or a co-sponsor, if each other co-
- 7 sponsor is either a medical school approved by the board or a
- 8 hospital owned by the federal government and directly operated by

- 1 the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, of not less than
- 2 4 postgraduate education residency programs approved by the board
- 3 under section 17031(1) for not less than the 3 years immediately
- 4 preceding the date of an application for a limited license under
- 5 section 16182(2)(c) or an application for a full license under
- 6 section 17031(2), if at least 1 of the residency programs is in the
- 7 specialty area of medical practice, or in a specialty area that
- 8 includes the subspecialty of medical practice, in which the
- 9 applicant for a limited license proposes to practice or in which
- 10 the applicant for a full license has practiced for the hospital.
- 11 (B) Has spent not less than \$2,000,000.00 for medical
- 12 education during each of the 3 years immediately preceding the date
- of an application for a limited license under section 16182(2)(c)
- 14 or an application for a full license under section 17031(2). As
- 15 used in this sub-subparagraph, "medical education" means the
- 16 education of physicians and candidates for degrees or licenses to
- 17 become physicians, including, but not limited to, physician staff,
- 18 residents, interns, and medical students.
- 19 (b) "Electrodiagnostic studies" means the testing of
- 20 neuromuscular functions utilizing nerve conduction tests and needle
- 21 electromyography. It does not include the use of surface
- **22** electromyography.
- (c) "Medical care services" means those services within the
- 24 scope of practice of physicians WHO ARE licensed OR AUTHORIZED by
- 25 the board, except those services that the board prohibits or
- 26 otherwise restricts within a practice agreement or determines shall
- 27 not be delegated by a physician without endangering the health and

- 1 safety of patients as provided for in section 17048(1).
- 2 (d) "Participating physician" means a physician, a physician
- 3 designated by a group of physicians under section 17049 to
- 4 represent that group, or a physician designated by a health
- 5 facility or agency under section 20174 to represent that health
- 6 facility or agency.
- 7 (e) "Physician" means an individual who is licensed OR
- 8 AUTHORIZED under this article to engage in the practice of
- 9 medicine.
- 10 (f) "Podiatrist" means an individual who is licensed under
- 11 this article to engage in the practice of podiatric medicine and
- 12 surgery.
- 13 (g) "Practice agreement" means an agreement described in
- **14** section 17047.
- 15 (h) "Practice of medicine" means the diagnosis, treatment,
- 16 prevention, cure, or relieving of a human disease, ailment, defect,
- 17 complaint, or other physical or mental condition, by attendance,
- 18 advice, device, diagnostic test, or other means, or offering,
- 19 undertaking, attempting to do, or holding oneself out as able to
- 20 do, any of these acts.
- 21 (i) "Practice as a physician's assistant" means the practice
- 22 of medicine with a participating physician under a practice
- 23 agreement.
- 24 (j) "Task force" means the joint task force created in section
- **25** 17025.
- 26 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 27 contains definitions and principles of construction applicable to

- 1 all articles in this code and part 161 contains definitions
- 2 applicable to this part.
- 3 SEC. 17011A. (1) AN ALLOPATHIC PHYSICIAN WHO HOLDS AN
- 4 EXPEDITED LICENSE UNDER THE INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT IS
- 5 AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE UNDER THIS
- 6 ARTICLE.
- 7 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, INCLUDING THE OBLIGATIONS OF
- 8 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED AS A PHYSICIAN UNDER THIS PART, AN
- 9 ALLOPATHIC PHYSICIAN WHO HOLDS AN EXPEDITED LICENSE UNDER THE
- 10 INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT IS CONSIDERED A PHYSICIAN WHO

- 15 Sec. 17501. (1) As used in this part:
- 16 (a) "Electrodiagnostic studies" means the testing of
- 17 neuromuscular functions utilizing nerve conduction tests and needle
- 18 electromyography. It does not include the use of surface
- 19 electromyography.
- 20 (b) "Medical care services" means those services within the
- 21 scope of practice of physicians WHO ARE licensed and approved OR
- 22 AUTHORIZED by the board, except those services that the board
- 23 prohibits or otherwise restricts within a practice agreement or
- 24 determines shall not be delegated by a physician without
- 25 endangering the health and safety of patients as provided for in
- **26** section 17548(1).
- (c) "Participating physician" means a physician, a physician

- 1 designated by a group of physicians under section 17549 to
- 2 represent that group, or a physician designated by a health

- 6 AUTHORIZED under this article to engage in the practice of
- 7 osteopathic medicine and surgery.
- 8 (e) "Practice agreement" means an agreement described in

- 10 (f) "Practice of osteopathic medicine and surgery" means a
- 11 separate, complete, and independent school of medicine and surgery
- 12 utilizing full methods of diagnosis and treatment in physical and
- 13 mental health and disease, including the prescription and
- 14 administration of drugs and biologicals, operative surgery,
- 15 obstetrics, radiological and other electromagnetic emissions, and
- 16 placing special emphasis on the interrelationship of the
- 17 musculoskeletal system to other body systems.

- 27 SEC. 17511A. (1) AN OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN WHO HOLDS AN

- EXPEDITED LICENSE UNDER THE INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT IS 1
- 2 AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND
