## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 4160

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 676b (MCL 257.676b).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 676b. (1) A—SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), A person, without
- 2 authority, shall not block, obstruct, impede, or otherwise
- 3 interfere with the normal flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic
- 4 upon a public street or highway in this state, by means of a
- 5 barricade, object, or device, or with his or her person. This
- 6 section shall DOES not apply to persons maintaining, rearranging,
- 7 or constructing public utility facilities in or adjacent to a
- 8 street or highway.
- 9 (2) SUBSECTION (1) AND ANY PROVISION OF THE MICHIGAN
- 10 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE THAT PROHIBITS A PERSON FROM STANDING IN A

- 1 ROADWAY OTHER THAN A LIMITED ACCESS HIGHWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 2 SOLICITING A RIDE, EMPLOYMENT, OR BUSINESS FROM THE OCCUPANT OF ANY
- 3 VEHICLE DO NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO IS SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS ON
- 4 BEHALF OF A CHARITABLE OR CIVIC ORGANIZATION DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS,
- 5 IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE SATISFIED:
- 6 (A) THE CHARITABLE OR CIVIC ORGANIZATION COMPLIES WITH
- 7 APPLICABLE LOCAL REGULATIONS.
- 8 (B) THE CHARITABLE OR CIVIC ORGANIZATION MAINTAINS AT LEAST
- 9 \$500,000.00 IN LIABILITY INSURANCE.
- 10 (C) THE PERSON IS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
- 11 (D) THE PERSON IS WEARING HIGH-VISIBILITY SAFETY APPAREL THAT
- 12 MEETS CURRENT AMERICAN STANDARDS PROMULGATED BY THE INTERNATIONAL
- 13 SAFETY EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATION.
- 14 (E) THE PORTION OF THE ROADWAY UPON WHICH THE SOLICITATION
- 15 OCCURS IS NOT A WORK ZONE AND IS WITHIN AN INTERSECTION WHERE
- 16 TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ARE PRESENT.
- 17 (3) A LOCAL AUTHORITY THAT HAS JURISDICTION OVER A ROADWAY
- 18 UPON WHICH SOLICITATION OCCURS AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) IS
- 19 NOT LIABLE FOR ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF THE
- 20 ROADWAY AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2).
- 21 (4)  $\frac{(2)}{}$  A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 22 a civil infraction.
- 23 (5) A LOCAL AUTHORITY MAY ENACT OR ENFORCE AN ORDINANCE THAT
- 24 PROHIBITS THE ACTIVITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2).
- 25 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CHARITABLE OR CIVIC
- 26 ORGANIZATION" MEANS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY
- 27 THIS STATE OR THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 1
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
