



# HOUSE BILL No. 4304

March 2, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Singh, Schor, LaSata, Green, Marino, Brann, Lucido, Sowerby, Ellison, Faris, Lasinski, Miller, Webber, Griffin, Glenn, Hughes, Kahle, Wentworth and Hoadley and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
 "The code of criminal procedure,"  
 by amending section 16x of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16x), as amended  
 by 2012 PA 323.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### 1 CHAPTER XVII

2 Sec. 16x. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
 3 enumerated in chapter 750 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
