SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4380

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 805 (MCL 257.805), as amended by 2013 PA 82.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 805. (1) An applicant for the issuance or renewal of a
- 2 motor vehicle registration or for a replacement registration tab or
- 3 sticker may submit a state park and state-operated public boating
- 4 access site passport fee to the secretary of state with the
- 5 application. Subject to subsection (7), the amount of the
- 6 recreation passport fee is as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided in subdivision (b), \$10.00.
- **8** (b) For a motorcycle, \$5.00.
- 9 (2) In addition to the requirements of section 217, an
- 10 application for a motor vehicle registration shall contain at least

- 1 the following information, in substantially the following format
- 2 and language, except that the amount of the recreation passport fee
- 3 specified shall be \$5.00 for a motorcycle:
- 4 \$[Amount] Annual vehicle registration or renewal.
- **5** \$10.00 Annual authorization to use this vehicle for
- 6 unlimited entry into all Michigan state parks
- 7 and recreation areas and DNR-operated state
- 8 boating access sites. (Check one of the
- 9 boxes below.)
- I elect to pay this \$10.00 fee.
- I elect not to pay this \$10.00 fee.
- 12 This vehicle will not be used to enter the
- facilities described above.
- 14 \$ Total amount due.
- 15 (3) The secretary of state may revise the format and language
- 16 of an application for motor vehicle registration to reflect the
- 17 fact that, under sections 74116 and 78119 of the natural resources
- 18 and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.74116 and
- 19 324.78119, payment of the recreation passport fee authorizes entry
- 20 into all state parks and recreation areas and designated state-
- 21 operated public boating access sites until expiration of the motor
- 22 vehicle registration.
- 23 (4) If the applicant applies by mail and, in addition to the
- 24 registration fee, the applicant pays an amount equal to the
- 25 recreation passport fee, the applicant shall be IS considered to
- 26 have elected to pay the recreation passport fee regardless of
- 27 whether such an election is indicated on the application.

- 1 (5) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to any of the
- 2 following:
- 3 (a) An application submitted by a dealer under section 217 for
- 4 a vehicle sold, leased, or exchanged by the dealer.
- 5 (b) The issuance or renewal of a ANY OF THE FOLLOWING motor
- 6 vehicle REGISTRATIONS:
- 7 (i) A registration described in section 803e(1) and exempt
- 8 under section 803e(6) from the registration tax. or the issuance or
- 9 renewal of a motor vehicle
- 10 (ii) A registration described in section 217d. or
- 11 (iii) A REGISTRATION FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN, DESCRIBED
- 12 IN SECTION 803f. A REGISTRATION TAB OR STICKER ISSUED FOR A
- 13 REGISTRATION DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH SHALL BE MARKED AS IF
- 14 THE RECREATION PASSPORT FEE HAS BEEN PAID, AS PROVIDED IN
- 15 SUBSECTION (9).
- 16 (6) The secretary of state shall, at least monthly, transfer
- 17 the revenue from recreation passport fees to the department of
- 18 natural resources and environment for deposit as provided in
- 19 section 2045 of the natural resources and environmental protection
- 20 act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.2045.
- 21 (7) For each calendar year, the state treasurer shall adjust
- 22 the amounts set forth in subsection (1) by an amount determined by
- 23 the state treasurer to reflect the cumulative percentage change in
- 24 the consumer price index from October 1, 2010 to the October 1
- 25 immediately preceding that calendar year, using the most recent
- 26 data available and rounded to the nearest dollar.
- 27 (8) The legislature shall annually review the amount of

- 1 revenue raised by the recreation passport fee to ensure that the
- 2 amount is appropriate for the purposes for which the recreation
- 3 passport fee is assessed and in compliance with law.
- **4** (9) If the secretary of state issues a registration tab or
- 5 sticker for a registration plate or personalized registration plate
- 6 under section 224 or 803b for a motor vehicle for which a
- 7 recreation passport fee has been paid under this section, the tab
- 8 or sticker shall be marked in a distinctive manner determined by
- 9 the secretary of state after consultation with the director of the
- 10 department of natural resources and the department of state police.
- 11 Before discontinuing the issuance of a registration tab or sticker,
- 12 the secretary of state shall consult with the director of the
- 13 department of natural resources and establish an alternative method
- 14 or procedure by which the department of natural resources can
- 15 determine whether a recreation passport fee has been paid for a
- 16 motor vehicle.
- 17 (10) Whether or not an individual paid or indicated that he or
- 18 she elected to pay or not to pay a recreation passport fee under
- 19 this section is personal information for purposes of section 40b.
- 20 (11) As used in this section:
- 21 (a) "Consumer price index" PRICE INDEX" means the most
- 22 comprehensive index of consumer prices available for this state
- 23 from the bureau of labor statistics BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS of
- 24 the United States department of labor. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, OR
- 25 SUCCESSOR AGENCY.
- (b) "Motor vehicle" does not include a commercial motor
- 27 vehicle.

- 1 (c) "Recreation passport fee" means the state park and state-
- 2 operated public boating access site recreation passport fee as
- 3 provided for in subsection (1).
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect February
- **5** 19, 2019.
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 7 unless House Bill No. 4381 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- **8** law.
