HOUSE BILL NO. 4405

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 17751a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 17751A. (1) A PHARMACIST MAY REFUSE TO DISPENSE A 1
- 2 PRESCRIPTION FOR A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE LISTED IN SCHEDULES 2 TO 5
- OF PART 72 IF THE PHARMACIST HAS A REASONABLE AND GOOD-FAITH BELIEF 3
- THAT THE PRESCRIPTION WAS NOT WRITTEN BY A PRESCRIBER IN GOOD FAITH
- OR HAS A REASONABLE AND GOOD-FAITH BELIEF THAT THE PRESCRIPTION IS 5
- BEING FILLED FOR A PURPOSE THAT IS NOT A MEDICAL PURPOSE. 6
- (2) A PHARMACIST WHO REFUSES TO DISPENSE A PRESCRIPTION AS 7
- PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS NOT LIABLE FOR DAMAGES IN A CIVIL 8
- 9 ACTION FOR INJURY, DEATH, OR LOSS TO PERSON OR PROPERTY ARISING
- 10 FROM THE PHARMACIST'S REFUSAL TO DISPENSE THE PRESCRIPTION.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 12 after the date it is enacted into law.
