## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 4495

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811d (MCL 257.811d), as amended by 2006 PA 562, and by adding section 811cc.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 811d. (1) As used in this chapter:
- 2 (a) "Fund-raising plate" means a registration plate authorized
- 3 to raise funds for a specified goal.
- 4 (b) "Collector plate" means a collector plate that matches any
- 5 registration plate developed and issued under this act.
- 6 (c) "Nonprofit" means that which is exempt from taxation under
- 7 section 501(c)(3) of ELIGIBLE FOR A CHARITABLE DEDUCTION UNDER the
- 8 UNITED STATES internal revenue code , 26 USC 501.OF 1986.

- 1 (d) "Transportation administration collection fund" means the
- 2 fund created under section 810b.
- 3 (2) A fund-raising plate shall contain all of the following as
- 4 prescribed or approved by the secretary of state:
- 5 (a) The same generic background.
- **6** (b) Letters and numbers.
- 7 (c) The word "Michigan" and any other unique identifier
- 8 specified by the secretary of state.
- 9 (d) A design or logo.
- 10 (3) If the design or logo of a fund-raising plate uses 1 or
- 11 more designs, trade names, trademarks, service marks, emblems,
- 12 symbols, or other images that are owned by a Michigan university or
- 13 other person, the Michigan university or other person shall grant
- 14 to or obtain for the secretary of state both of the following
- 15 pursuant to a written agreement between the parties:
- 16 (a) A nonexclusive worldwide license to use those designs,
- 17 trade names, trademarks, service marks, emblems, symbols, or other
- 18 images on and in conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale,
- 19 or copyrighting of the registration plate or image of the fund-
- 20 raising plate.
- (b) The authority to merchandise the fund-raising plate or an
- 22 image of the fund-raising plate.
- 23 (4) In using or employing a design, trade name, trademark,
- 24 service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in
- 25 conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or
- 26 merchandising of a fund-raising plate or image of the fund-raising
- 27 plate, the secretary of state may alter the size of the design,

- 1 trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other
- 2 image but shall not change the color or design of the design, trade
- 3 name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image
- 4 without the prior written consent of the respective Michigan
- 5 university or other person. The secretary of state shall not use or
- 6 employ a design, trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem,
- 7 symbol, logo, or other image on and in conjunction with the
- 8 marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or merchandising of a
- 9 fund-raising plate or an image of the fund-raising plate in any
- 10 manner that is offensive to the Michigan university or other person
- 11 that owns the design, trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem,
- 12 symbol, logo, or other image that is the subject of a written
- 13 agreement under subsection (3).
- 14 SEC. 811CC. (1) NO LATER THAN AUGUST 1, 2019, THE SECRETARY OF
- 15 STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F
- 16 A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE RECOGNIZING THE KIWANIS
- 17 INTERNATIONAL MICHIGAN DISTRICT. THE FUND-RAISING PLATE OR
- 18 COLLECTOR PLATE AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BEAR AN
- 19 APPROPRIATE LOGO, THE DESIGN OF WHICH THE KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL
- 20 MICHIGAN DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 21 (2) THE KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL MICHIGAN DISTRICT FUND IS
- 22 CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE
- 23 MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND.
- 24 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE
- 25 STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM
- 26 FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR
- 27 SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

- (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY 1
- 2 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING THE KIWANIS
- INTERNATIONAL MICHIGAN DISTRICT TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL 3
- 4 CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 5 (2).
- (4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND 6
- ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE 7
- KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL MICHIGAN DISTRICT. 8
- (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE FUND 9
- 10 CREATED IN SUBSECTION (2) FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 12 after the date it is enacted into law.
