## **HOUSE BILL No. 4500**

April 20, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Hornberger and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled

"The code of criminal procedure,"

by amending section 39 of chapter XVII (MCL 777.39), as amended by 2006 PA 548.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

2	Sec. 39. (1) Offense variable 9 is number of victims. Score
3	offense variable 9 by determining which of the following apply and
4	by assigning the number of points attributable to the one that has
5	the highest number of points:

CHAPTER XVII

- (a) Multiple deaths occurred...... 100 points
- (b) There were 10 or more victims who were
- 8 placed in danger of physical injury or death,

1	or 20 or more victims who were placed in danger
2	of property loss
3	(c) There were 2 to 9 victims who were
4	placed in danger of physical injury or death, or
5	4 to 19 victims who were placed in danger of
6	property loss
7	(d) There were fewer than 2 victims who were
8	placed in danger of physical injury or death,
9	or fewer than 4 victims who were placed in danger
10	of property loss 0 points
11	(2) All of the following apply to scoring offense variable 9:
12	(a) Count each person who was placed in danger of physical
13	injury or loss of life or property as a victim. FOR PURPOSES OF
14	THIS SECTION, AN EMBRYO OR FETUS MUST BE COUNTED AS A PERSON.
15	(b) Score 100 points only in homicide cases.
16	Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
17	after the date it is enacted into law.
