## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 4654

A bill to amend 2016 PA 407, entitled "Skilled trades regulation act," by amending section 733 (MCL 339.5733).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 733. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 this article does not apply in the jurisdiction of a municipality
- 3 that adopts or has adopted an ordinance that does all of the
- 4 following:
- 5 (a) Provides standards for the examination and licensing of
- 6 master electricians, electrical or specialty contractors,
- 7 electrical journeymen, sign specialists, and fire alarm specialty
- 8 technicians and the registration of apprentice electricians and
- 9 fire alarm specialty apprentice technicians that are at least as
- 10 stringent as those established in this article.

- 1 (b) Provides for enforcement that is substantially similar to
- 2 this article.
- 3 (c) Provides for civil and criminal penalties and a citation
- 4 system for minor violations substantially similar to article 5.
- 5 (d) Provides for the inspection of electrical wiring and
- 6 equipment.
- 7 (2) This article shall not be construed as limiting the power
- 8 of a municipality to enact an ordinance described in subsection
- 9 (1), to provide for the licensing of persons as electrical or
- 10 specialty contractors that have a place of business located in the
- 11 municipality, or to provide for the licensing of journeymen
- 12 electricians, sign specialists, or fire alarm specialty technicians
- 13 who reside in the municipality, except that the ordinance shall not
- 14 require any of the following:
- 15 (a) The procurement of a license or permit to execute the
- 16 classes of work specified in section 737(3)(c), (d), (e), and (f).
- 17 (b) The procurement of a permit by a provider to install,
- 18 maintain, replace, or service any electrical wiring, equipment, or
- 19 devices associated WITH A BUSINESS MONITORING SYSTEM OR with a home
- 20 monitoring system. As used in this subdivision and subdivision (c):
- 21 (i) "BUSINESS MONITORING SYSTEM" MEANS A DEVICE OR AN ASSEMBLY
- 22 OF EQUIPMENT AND DEVICES, LESS THAN 50 VOLTS, THAT ALLOWS A
- 23 BUSINESS TO REMOTELY MONITOR ITS BUSINESS PREMISES THROUGH AUDIO,
- 24 VIDEO, OR SENSOR DETECTION SYSTEMS. A BUSINESS MONITORING SYSTEM
- 25 DOES NOT INCLUDE A FIRE ALARM SYSTEM OR A LIFE SAFETY SYSTEM
- 26 DESIGNED TO PROTECT AND EVACUATE BUILDING OCCUPANTS IN THE EVENT OF
- 27 EMERGENCIES SUCH AS FIRE, SMOKE, OR POWER OUTAGES.

- 1 (ii) (i) "Home monitoring system" means a device or an
- 2 assembly of equipment and devices that allows individuals to
- 3 remotely monitor their home through audio, video, or sensor
- 4 detection systems and that may allow them to remotely control the
- 5 home's environment, including, but not limited to, controlling
- 6 temperature, humidity, lighting, doors, or locks.
- 7 (iii) "Provider" means a system provider that is
- 8 registered under the security alarm systems act, 2012 PA 580, MCL
- 9 338.2181 to 338.2187, or a security alarm system contractor that is
- 10 licensed under the private security business and security alarm
- 11 act, 1968 PA 330, MCL 338.1051 to 338.1092.
- 12 (c) The procurement of a license or permit by a provider to
- 13 install, maintain, replace, or service a security alarm system. As
- 14 used in this subdivision, "security alarm system" means that term
- 15 as defined in section 2 of the security alarm systems act, 2012 PA
- 16 580, MCL 338.2182, or section 2 of the private security business
- 17 and security alarm act, 1968 PA 330, MCL 338.1052.
- 18 (d) The procurement of public liability insurance in excess of
- 19 the coverage required under this article.
- 20 (3) A license or registration issued by the board under this
- 21 article and licenses issued by a municipality that has standards
- 22 for licensing at least as stringent as those established by the
- 23 board shall be recognized by all municipalities.
- 24 (4) A municipality that provides for electrical inspection by
- 25 local ordinance may require all electrical or specialty
- 26 contractors, sign specialists, fire alarm specialty technicians,
- 27 and classes of electricians doing work in the municipality to

- 1 register in accordance with its local ordinance.
- 2 (5) Municipal registration requirements shall be reciprocal
- 3 between the municipalities and between municipalities and the board
- 4 as to registration requirements and fees, except that licensed
- 5 electrical journeymen, sign specialists, and fire alarm specialty
- 6 technicians are not required to register to work in municipalities
- 7 under the jurisdiction of the board. A municipality shall
- 8 officially recognize a license or registration issued under this
- 9 article for purposes of its ordinance.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
