## HOUSE BILL NO. 4696

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"

(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 1m to chapter IX.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER IX
- 2 SEC. 1M. (1) THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR SHALL DEVELOP AND
- 3 PROVIDE AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE REGARDING JUVENILES
- 4 LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE TRIED FOR FELONIES OR MISDEMEANORS IN A
- 5 COURT OF GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION IN THE SAME MANNER AS
- 6 ADULTS. THE REPORT MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE LEGISLATURE
- 7 ELECTRONICALLY AND MUST INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE
- 8 FOLLOWING:
- 9 (A) THE NUMBER OF JUVENILES IN THIS STATE PROSECUTED AS ADULTS
- 10 IN A COURT HAVING GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION FOR A FELONY,

- 1 MISDEMEANOR, OR TRAFFIC OFFENSE, AND IF CONVICTED, THE SENTENCE
- 2 ENTERED BY THE COURT.
- (B) THE NUMBER OF MOTIONS UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE PROBATE CODE 3
- 4 OF 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 712A.4, BY THE PROSECUTOR OF EACH COUNTY
- TO TRANSFER JUVENILE MATTERS FROM A PROBATE COURT TO A COURT HAVING 5
- 6 GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION OF THE OFFENSE.
- 7 (C) FOR THOSE JUVENILES WHO ARE TRIED FOR FELONIES OR
- MISDEMEANORS IN A COURT OF GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION IN THE 8
- 9 SAME MANNER AS ADULTS, WHETHER THOSE INDIVIDUALS WERE REPRESENTED
- 10 BY COUNSEL, AND IF SO, WHETHER THE COUNSEL WAS APPOINTED OR
- 11 RETAINED.
- 12 (D) THE RATE OF RECIDIVISM FOR JUVENILES TRIED FOR FELONIES OR
- MISDEMEANORS IN A COURT OF GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION IN THE 13
- 14 SAME MANNER AS ADULTS.
- 15 (2) THE ANNUAL REPORT MUST INCLUDE BOTH OF, BUT NOT BE LIMITED
- TO, THE FOLLOWING DEMOGRAPHIC AND GEOGRAPHIC DATA FOR EACH JUVENILE 16
- 17 TRIED FOR A FELONY OR MISDEMEANOR CRIMINAL OFFENSE IN A COURT OF
- 18 GENERAL CRIMINAL JURISDICTION IN THE SAME MANNER AS AN ADULT:
- 19 (A) A JUVENILE'S CUSTODY STATUS AND CUSTODY HISTORY IF THE
- 20 JUVENILE WAS IN THE LEGAL CUSTODY OF AN INDIVIDUAL OTHER THAN HIS
- 21 OR HER BIOLOGICAL PARENT AT ANY TIME BEFORE HIS OR HER
- 22 INCARCERATION.
- 23 (B) A JUVENILE'S EDUCATIONAL AND SCHOOL HISTORY INCLUDING
- 24 SCHOOLS ATTENDED, GRADES COMPLETED, AND SUSPENSIONS OR EXPULSIONS.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
- 26 1, 2021.
