



HOUSE BILL No. 5131

October 17, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Kosowski and Marino and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 697 (MCL 168.697).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 697. At the general November election, the names of the
2 several offices to be voted for ~~shall~~ **MUST** be placed on the ballot
3 substantially in the following order in the years in which
4 elections for ~~such~~ **THOSE** offices are held: Electors of ~~president~~
5 **PRESIDENT** and ~~vice-president~~ **VICE PRESIDENT** of the United States;
6 governor and lieutenant governor; secretary of state; attorney
7 general; United States ~~senator; representative~~ **SENATOR;**
8 **REPRESENTATIVE** in ~~congress~~ **CONGRESS**; senator and representative in
9 the state legislature; members of the state board of education;
10 regents of the ~~university~~ **UNIVERSITY** of Michigan; trustees of
11 Michigan ~~state university;~~ **STATE UNIVERSITY**; governors of Wayne

~~state university; STATE UNIVERSITY;~~ county executive; prosecuting
 attorney; sheriff; clerk; treasurer; register of deeds; ~~auditor in~~
~~counties electing an auditor;~~ mine inspector in counties electing a
 mine inspector; county road commissioners; drain commissioners;
 coroners; and surveyor. The following township officers ~~shall~~ **MUST**
 be placed on the same ballot as above described in substantially
 the following order in the year in which elections for ~~such~~ **THOSE**
 offices are held: supervisor, clerk, treasurer, trustees, and
 constables.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.

Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 99th Legislature are enacted into law:
