

## **SENATE BILL No. 426**

June 6, 2017, Introduced by Senator NOFS and referred to the Committee on Elections and Government Reform.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 509m (MCL 168.509m), as amended by 2005 PA 71.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 509m. (1) The purposes of this section and sections 509n 2 to 509hh-509II are all of the following:
  - (a) To establish a statewide qualified voter file that consists of all qualified electors who wish to be registered to vote in local, state, and federal elections.
    - (b) To enhance the uniformity of the administration of elections by creating and maintaining a statewide qualified voter file.
    - (c) To increase the efficiency and decrease the public cost of maintaining voter registration files and implementing the national voter registration act of 1993.

- (d) To increase the integrity of the voting process by
  creating a single qualified voter file that will permit the name of
  each citizen of this state to appear only once and that is compiled
- 4 from other state files that require citizens to verify their
- 5 identity and residence.
- **6** (e) To apply technology and information gathered by principal
- 7 executive departments, state agencies, and county, city, township,
- 8 and village clerks in a manner that ensures that accurate and
- 9 current records of qualified voters are maintained.
- 10 (2) As used in sections 509n to 509hh:509II:
- 11 (a) "Designated voter registration agency" means an office
- 12 designated under section 509u to perform voter registration
- 13 activities in this state.
- 14 (b) "Qualified voter file" means the statewide qualified voter
- 15 file established according to section 509o.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 18 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 19 unless all of the following bills of the 99th Legislature are
- 20 enacted into law:
