by amending section 509x (MCL 168.509x), as added by 1994 PA 441.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 509x. An application for registration is considered to be received on or before the close of registration τ if 1 of the 2 3 following requirements is met:
 - (a) An application is received at a department of state office, a designated voter registration agency, or the office of a county, city, or township clerk on or before the close of registration.
 - (b) An application is received through the mail that is postmarked on or before the close of registration.
 - (c) An application is received through the mail on or before the seventh day immediately following the close of registration, if the postmark is missing or is unclear and the application, on its 02318'17 STM

- 2 registration. The clerk shall consider an application received
- 3 pursuant to UNDER this subdivision as received before the close of
- 4 registration.
- 5 (D) AN APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY THROUGH THE
- 6 ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION INTERFACE ON OR BEFORE THE CLOSE OF
- 7 REGISTRATION.
