SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 157

A bill to preempt local ordinances regulating, prohibiting, restricting, or mandating the use of certain materials for certain public works projects; and to allow competition for the use or supply of certain materials and products on certain public works projects.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "public works quality materials procurement act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Ordinance" means an ordinance, resolution, or other
- 5 appropriate legislative enactment of the governing body of a public
- 6 entity. Ordinance does not include design or construction
- 7 specifications developed by a professional engineer in consultation

- 1 with the public entity that are specific to a particular public
- 2 works project.
- 3 (b) "Pipe and piping materials" means pipes and piping
- 4 materials used to transport drinking water and wastewater.
- 5 (c) "Public entity" means a school district, community college
- 6 district, intermediate school district, city, village, township,
- 7 county, public authority, or public airport authority.
- 8 (d) "Public funds" includes state legislative appropriations
- 9 and state tax revenue for public works projects.
- 10 (e) "Public works project" means a water supply project or a
- 11 wastewater project.
- 12 (f) "Wastewater project" means sanitary sewers, pipe and
- 13 piping materials, interceptors or waste treatment facilities, and
- 14 facilities for the collection and disposal of liquid and solid
- 15 waste.
- (g) "Water supply project" means pipe and piping materials,
- 17 lines, and other facilities needed for the pumping, treatment, and
- 18 distribution of drinking water.
- 19 Sec. 3. (1) A public entity shall not adopt or enforce an
- 20 ordinance that prohibits, restricts, or limits the evaluation,
- 21 comparison, or usage of certain pipe and piping materials that meet
- 22 current American Society for Testing and Materials, American Water
- 23 Works Association, or NSF International standards to be used for a
- 24 public works project that is financed in whole or in part by public
- 25 funds.
- 26 (2) Subsection (1) does not limit the professional judgment of
- 27 the project's engineer to specify or select any acceptable pipe and

- 1 piping materials based on the performance requirements for the
- 2 particular public works project.
