SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 356

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 502.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 502. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A SALESPERSON LICENSE
- 2 TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A SALESPERSON
- 3 ACCREDITATION PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (6) AND WHO IS A DESIGNATED
- 4 EMPLOYEE OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PERSONS:
- 5 (A) A VENDOR OF SPIRITS.
- 6 (B) A BROKER.
- 7 (C) A MANUFACTURER OF BEER.
- 8 (D) A MANUFACTURER OF WINE.
- 9 (E) AN OUTSTATE SELLER OF BEER.
- 10 (F) AN OUTSTATE SELLER OF WINE.
- 11 (G) A WHOLESALER.

- 1 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT ISSUE A SALESPERSON LICENSE UNDER
- 2 THIS SECTION UNLESS THE APPLICANT SUBMITS WITH HIS OR HER
- 3 APPLICATION WRITTEN DOCUMENTATION THAT THE APPLICANT SUCCESSFULLY
- 4 COMPLETED A SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (6).
- 5 (3) A SALESPERSON LICENSE IS VALID FOR 3 YEARS, BEGINNING ON
- 6 THE DATE IT IS ISSUED OR RENEWED.
- 7 (4) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL
- 8 NOT SELL, DELIVER, PROMOTE, OR OTHERWISE ASSIST IN THE SALE OF
- 9 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN ANY MANNER TO A RETAILER IN THIS STATE UNLESS
- 10 LICENSED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 11 (5) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT
- 12 LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE AND WHO ONLY DOES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING TO BE
- 13 LICENSED AS A SALESPERSON:
- 14 (A) BUILDS A DISPLAY OF THOSE BRANDS THAT ARE REPRESENTED OR
- 15 SOLD BY THE INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER FOR AN OFF-PREMISES RETAILER.
- 16 (B) MARKS THE PRICE ON THOSE BRANDS THAT ARE REPRESENTED OR
- 17 SOLD BY THE INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER FOR AN OFF-PREMISES RETAILER.
- 18 (C) ROTATES BRANDS THAT ARE REPRESENTED OR SOLD BY THE
- 19 INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER FOR AN OFF-PREMISES RETAILER.
- 20 (D) PLACES BRANDS THAT ARE REPRESENTED OR SOLD BY THE
- 21 INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER ON SHELVES FOR AN OFF-PREMISES RETAILER.
- 22 (E) THE HOLDER OF A MICHIGAN COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE OR
- 23 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE WHO TRANSPORTS, IN A VEHICLE LICENSED BY THE
- 24 COMMISSION UNDER SECTION 525, AND DELIVERS ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO A
- 25 RETAILER.
- 26 (6) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPROVE A SALESPERSON LICENSE
- 27 ACCREDITATION PROGRAM DESIGNED FOR SALESPERSON LICENSEES IF THE

- 1 COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT THE PROGRAM'S CURRICULUM INCLUDES AN
- 2 UNDERSTANDING OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) SECTION 609.
- 4 (B) SECTION 609A.
- 5 (C) SECTION 609B.
- 6 (D) THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1013 THAT REQUIRE THE SALE OR
- 7 PURCHASE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY A LICENSEE FOR CASH ONLY.
- 8 (E) R 436.1315 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
- 9 (F) R 436.1319 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
- 10 (G) R 436.1726 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
- 11 (H) THE COMMISSION'S ORDER FOR ON-PREMISES BRAND PROMOTIONS
- 12 ISSUED OCTOBER 27, 1999.
- 13 (I) THE COMMISSION'S ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-05 FOR PRODUCT
- 14 ADJUSTMENTS.
- 15 (7) A PERSON MAY APPLY TO THE COMMISSION FOR QUALIFICATION AS
- 16 AN ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE OFFERING OF A SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION
- 17 PROGRAM.
- 18 (8) ON APPROVAL OF A SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION PROGRAM UNDER
- 19 SUBSECTION (6), THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT THE PERSON SPONSORING
- 20 THE SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION PROGRAM AS ADMINISTRATOR OF THAT
- 21 PROGRAM.
- 22 (9) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 23 (A) "ADMINISTRATOR" MEANS A QUALIFIED TRADE ORGANIZATION
- 24 AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION TO OFFER SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION
- 25 PROGRAMS.
- 26 (B) "BROKER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 609.
- 27 (C) "DESIGNATED EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SELLS,

- DELIVERS, PROMOTES, OR OTHERWISE ASSISTS IN THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC 1
- 2 LIQUOR.
- (D) "QUALIFIED TRADE ORGANIZATION" MEANS A TRADE ORGANIZATION 3
- THAT REPRESENTS A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) (A) TO (F) THAT
- EMPLOYS INDIVIDUALS TO ACT AS SALESPERSONS. 5
- (E) "SALESPERSON ACCREDITATION PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT
- THE COMMISSION APPROVES UNDER SUBSECTION (6) AND THAT IS OFFERED BY 7
- AN ADMINISTRATOR. 8
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days 9
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
