SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 545

A bill to amend 2000 PA 161, entitled "Michigan education savings program act,"

(MCL 390.1471 to 390.1486) by adding sections 21 and 22.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21. (1) FROM THE INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM EACH PUBLIC
- 2 SCHOOL PURSUANT TO SECTION 1210 OF THE REVISED SCHOOL CODE, 1976 PA
- 3 451, MCL 380.1210, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL DETERMINE
- 4 WHICH SERVICES OFFERED BY EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL ARE ELIGIBLE SERVICES
- 5 THAT MAY BE PURCHASED USING AN ACCOUNT. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
- 6 SHALL DIVIDE THE ELIGIBLE SERVICES INTO 5 SEPARATE CATEGORIES AS
- 7 FOLLOWS:
- 8 (A) CORE INSTRUCTION.
- 9 (B) NONCORE INSTRUCTION.
- 10 (C) EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

- 1 (D) SUPPORT ACTIVITIES.
- 2 (E) COURSE MATERIALS.
- (2) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT COMPLIES WITH SECTION 1210 OF THE 3
- 4 REVISED SCHOOL CODE, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1210, IS ELIGIBLE TO
- RECEIVE PAYMENTS FROM THE PROGRAM. THE DEPARTMENT MAY DESIGNATE 5
- OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE CORE AND NONCORE INSTRUCTION
- 7 SERVICES, EXTRACURRICULAR AND SUPPORT ACTIVITIES, AND COURSE
- 8 MATERIALS AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE PAYMENTS FROM THE PROGRAM.
- SEC. 22. WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS 9
- SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF 10
- 11 EDUCATION, SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN AN INTERNET WEBSITE
- 12 DEDICATED TO THIS PROGRAM. THE WEBSITE SHALL SERVE AS THE PORTAL
- FOR INFORMATION ABOUT THE ENHANCED MICHIGAN EDUCATION SAVINGS 13
- ACCOUNTS AND THE ELIGIBLE SERVICES OFFERED BY EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL 14
- AND ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION IN THIS STATE. THE WEBSITE SHALL INCLUDE 15
- AT LEAST BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING: 16
- 17 (A) A BREAKDOWN OF THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ANNUAL COURSE
- LOADS AND COURSE DESCRIPTIONS. 18
- 19 (B) A MECHANISM FOR THE ENROLLMENT OF STUDENTS INTO SERVICES
- AND TO ALLOW FOR THE PAYMENT OF THOSE ELIGIBLE SERVICES FROM EACH 20
- STUDENT'S ACCOUNT BY THE ACCOUNT OWNER. 21
