SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5596

A bill to allow local governments and certain authorities to withhold payment under certain conditions to contractors on an asbestos abatement project; to provide for mandatory contract conditions on certain asbestos abatement projects; to provide for certain disclosures; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain local officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Asbestos" means a group of naturally occurring minerals
- 3 that separate into fibers, including chrysotile, amosite,
- 4 crocidolite, anthophyllite, tremolite, and actinolite.
- 5 (b) "Asbestos abatement contractor" means a business entity
- 6 that is licensed under the asbestos abatement contractors licensing
- 7 act, 1986 PA 135, MCL 338.3101 to 338.3319, and that carries on the

- 1 business of asbestos abatement on the premises of another business
- 2 entity and not on the asbestos abatement contractor's premises.
- 3 (c) "Asbestos abatement project" means any activity involving
- 4 persons working directly with the demolition, renovation, or
- 5 encapsulation of friable asbestos materials.
- 6 (d) "Local government" means a county, city, village, or
- 7 township.
- 8 Sec. 3. Beginning on the effective date of this act, if a
- 9 local government or a land bank authority created under section 23
- 10 of the land bank fast track act, 2003 PA 258, MCL 124.773, enters
- 11 into a contract with an asbestos abatement contractor or a
- 12 demolition contractor that involves an asbestos abatement project,
- 13 the contract must include a provision that the local government or
- 14 land bank authority may withhold any payment to that asbestos
- 15 abatement contractor or demolition contractor if the asbestos
- 16 abatement contractor, demolition contractor, or any subcontractor
- 17 of the asbestos abatement contractor or demolition contractor on
- 18 that asbestos abatement project has entered into, or is in
- 19 negotiations to enter into, an administrative consent order or
- 20 consent judgment with the department of environmental quality or
- 21 another environmental regulatory agency within the immediately
- 22 preceding 12 months that involves violations of environmental
- 23 regulations. Payment may be withheld by the local government or
- 24 land bank authority until the local government or land bank
- 25 authority receives verification from the asbestos abatement
- 26 contractor, the demolition contractor, the department of
- 27 environmental quality, or another environmental regulatory agency

- 1 that the violations of environmental regulations related to the
- 2 administrative consent order or consent judgment, or a proposed
- 3 administrative consent order or consent judgment, have been
- 4 corrected.
- 5 Sec. 5. If involved in an asbestos abatement project with a
- 6 local government or land bank authority, an asbestos abatement
- 7 contractor, demolition contractor, or any subcontractor of the
- 8 asbestos abatement contractor or demolition contractor must
- 9 disclose to the local government or land bank authority if that
- 10 asbestos abatement contractor, demolition contractor, or
- 11 subcontractor is subject to an active administrative consent order
- 12 or consent judgment, or has entered into, or is in negotiations to
- 13 enter into, an administrative consent order or consent judgment,
- 14 with the department of environmental quality or another
- 15 environmental regulatory agency for any violations of environmental
- 16 regulations.
