## HOUSE BILL NO. 5604

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1538d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1538D. (1) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL
- 2 NOT APPROVE A TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION UNDER SECTION 1538A
- 3 AND R 390.1151 TO R 390.1153 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
- 4 UNLESS THE TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION MEETS BOTH OF THE
- 5 FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) OFFERS A STUDENT TEACHING PROGRAM TO ITS STUDENTS THAT
- 7 INCLUDES AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (i) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR
- 9 BOTH, IN A RURAL SETTING.
- 10 (ii) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR

- 1 BOTH, IN AN URBAN SETTING.
- 2 (iii) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR
- 3 BOTH, THAT INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, AND
- 4 RESTORATIVE LEARNING PRACTICES.
- 5 (iv) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR
- 6 BOTH, WITH PUPILS WHO ARE ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS.
- 7 (v) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR
- 8 BOTH, IN SCHOOLS WITH A HIGH POPULATION OF PUPILS LIVING IN
- 9 POVERTY.
- 10 (vi) STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCES OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES, OR
- 11 BOTH, WITH PUPILS WITH A DISABILITY.
- 12 (vii) A PROHIBITION ON A STUDENT TEACHER ENGAGING IN STUDENT
- 13 TEACHING IN A SCHOOL THAT THE STUDENT TEACHER ATTENDED. A TEACHER
- 14 PREPARATION INSTITUTION MAY LIFT THE PROHIBITION UNDER THIS
- 15 SUBPARAGRAPH FOR A STUDENT TEACHER IF THE PROHIBITION WOULD IMPOSE
- 16 AN UNREASONABLE BURDEN ON THE STUDENT TEACHER, AS DETERMINED BY THE
- 17 DEPARTMENT.
- 18 (viii) AN INTRODUCTION TO THE EVALUATION TOOL USED BY THE
- 19 SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 20 ACADEMY IN WHICH THE STUDENT TEACHER COMPLETES HIS OR HER STUDENT
- 21 TEACHING EXPERIENCE.
- 22 (ix) THE USE OF DATA AND STATISTICS TO INFORM INSTRUCTION AND
- 23 TO AGGREGATE LOCAL AND STATE ASSESSMENT DATA.
- 24 (x) DEVELOPMENT OF CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT SKILLS.
- 25 (B) ENTERS INTO A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH EACH SCHOOL
- 26 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IN
- 27 WHICH THE TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION PLACES STUDENT TEACHERS

- THAT INCLUDES AT LEAST BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING: 1
- 2 (i) METHODS OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE TEACHER PREPARATION
- INSTITUTION AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, 3
- OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY. 4
- 5 (ii) EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT TEACHERS, COOPERATING TEACHERS,
- 6 SCHOOL DISTRICTS, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 7 ACADEMIES, AND STUDENT TEACHING SUPERVISORS AT THE TEACHER
- PREPARATION INSTITUTION, INCLUDING STANDARDS FOR SITE VISITS AND 8
- 9 FEEDBACK.
- (2) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019, IF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 10
- 11 INSTRUCTION APPROVED A TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION UNDER
- 12 SECTION 1538A AND R 390.1151 TO 390.1153 OF THE MICHIGAN
- ADMINISTRATIVE CODE BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION AND 13
- 14 THE TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION DID NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS
- UNDER THIS SECTION AT THE TIME THE APPROVAL WAS ISSUED, THE 15
- SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL REVOKE THE APPROVAL. IF 16
- 17 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION REVOKES AN APPROVAL UNDER
- 18 THIS SUBSECTION, THE TEACHER PREPARATION INSTITUTION MAY REAPPLY
- 19 FOR APPROVAL, IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT
- 20 OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.
- 21 (3) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT A TEACHER
- 22 PREPARATION INSTITUTION NOT CHARGE A STUDENT WHO IS ENGAGED IN
- 23 STUDENT TEACHING A RATE OF TUITION THAT EXCEEDS THE APPLICABLE
- 24 UNDERGRADUATE TUITION RATE.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 26 after the date it is enacted into law.
