SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5678

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7303a (MCL 333.7303a), as amended by 2017 PA 249.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7303a. (1) A prescriber who holds a controlled substances
- 2 license may administer or dispense a controlled substance listed in
- 3 schedules 2 to 5 without a separate controlled substances license
- 4 for those activities.
- 5 (2) Except as otherwise provided in rules promulgated under
- 6 section 16204e, beginning March 31, 2018, a licensed prescriber
- 7 shall not prescribe a controlled substance listed in schedules 2 to
- 8 5 unless the prescriber is in a bona fide prescriber-patient

- 1 relationship with the patient for whom the controlled substance is
- 2 being prescribed. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 3 if a licensed prescriber prescribes a controlled substance under
- 4 this subsection, the prescriber shall provide follow-up care to the
- 5 patient to monitor the efficacy of the use of the controlled
- 6 substance as a treatment of the patient's medical condition. If the
- 7 licensed prescriber is unable to provide follow-up care, he or she
- 8 shall refer the patient to the patient's primary care provider for
- 9 follow-up care or, if the patient does not have a primary care
- 10 provider, he or she shall refer the patient to another licensed
- 11 prescriber who is geographically accessible to the patient for
- 12 follow-up care.
- 13 (3) Before prescribing or dispensing a controlled substance to
- 14 a patient, a licensed prescriber shall ask the patient about other
- 15 controlled substances the patient may be using. The prescriber
- 16 shall record the patient's response in the patient's medical or
- 17 clinical record.
- 18 (4) Beginning June 1, 2018, before prescribing or dispensing
- 19 to a patient a controlled substance in a quantity that exceeds a 3-
- 20 day supply, a licensed prescriber shall obtain and review a report
- 21 concerning that patient from the electronic system for monitoring
- 22 schedule 2, 3, 4, and 5 controlled substances established under
- 23 section 7333a. This subsection does not apply under any of the
- 24 following circumstances:
- 25 (a) If the dispensing occurs in a hospital or freestanding
- 26 surgical outpatient facility licensed under article 17 and the
- 27 controlled substance is administered to the patient in that

- 1 hospital or facility.
- 2 (b) If the patient is an animal as that term is defined in
- 3 section 18802, the dispensing occurs in a veterinary hospital or
- 4 clinic and the controlled substance is administered to the patient
- 5 in that hospital or clinic.
- **6** (c) If the controlled substance is prescribed by a licensed
- 7 prescriber who is a veterinarian and the controlled substance will
- 8 be dispensed by a pharmacist.
- 9 (5) Beginning June 1, 2018, before prescribing or dispensing a
- 10 controlled substance to a patient, a licensed prescriber shall
- 11 register with the electronic system for monitoring schedule 2, 3,
- 12 4, and 5 controlled substances established under section 7333a.
- 13 (6) A licensed prescriber who dispenses controlled substances
- 14 shall maintain all of the following records separately from other
- 15 prescription records:
- 16 (a) All invoices and other acquisition records for each
- 17 controlled substance acquired by the prescriber for not less than 5
- 18 years after the date the prescriber acquires the controlled
- 19 substance.
- 20 (b) A log of all controlled substances dispensed by the
- 21 prescriber for not less than 5 years after the date the controlled
- 22 substance is dispensed.
- 23 (c) Records of all other dispositions of controlled substances
- 24 under the licensee's control for not less than 5 years after the
- 25 date of the disposition.
- 26 (7) The requirement under section 7303 for a license is waived
- 27 in the following circumstances:

- 1 (a) When a controlled substance listed in schedules 2 to 5 is
- 2 administered on the order of a licensed prescriber by an individual
- 3 who is licensed under article 15 as a practical nurse or a
- 4 registered professional nurse.
- 5 (b) When methadone or a methadone congener is dispensed on the
- 6 order of a licensed prescriber in a methadone treatment program
- 7 licensed under article 6 or when a controlled substance listed in
- 8 schedules 2 to 5 is dispensed on the order of a licensed prescriber
- 9 in a hospice rendering emergency care services in a patient's home
- 10 as described in section 17746 by a registered professional nurse
- 11 licensed under article 15.
- 12 (8) As used in this section:
- 13 (a) "Bona fide prescriber-patient relationship" means a
- 14 treatment or counseling relationship between a prescriber and a
- 15 patient in which both of the following are present:
- 16 (i) The prescriber has reviewed the patient's relevant medical
- 17 or clinical records and completed a full AN assessment of the
- 18 patient's medical history and current medical condition, including
- 19 a relevant medical evaluation of the patient conducted in person or
- 20 via THROUGH telehealth OR BY AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE
- 21 15 TO WHOM THE PRESCRIBER HAS DELEGATED THE AUTHORITY TO PERFORM
- 22 THE EVALUATION UNDER SECTION 16215.
- 23 (ii) The prescriber has created and maintained records of the
- 24 patient's condition in accordance with medically accepted
- 25 standards.
- (b) "Telehealth" means that term as defined in section 16283.
