HOUSE BILL No. 5740

March 21, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Farrington and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to establish the Kiwanis fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "Kiwanis fund act".

3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:

- (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- (b) "Fund" means the Kiwanis fund created in section 5.

Sec. 5. (1) The Kiwanis fund is created in the department to provide funds for donation to any Kiwanis club or organization $\left(\frac{1}{2} \right)$

- 2 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 3 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 4 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.
- 5 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 6 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 7 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 8 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
- 9 things of value received by the fund.
- 10 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- **11** fund.
- Sec. 7. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund
- 13 shall be expended solely for the purposes described in this act.
- 14 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the
- 15 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation to each
- 16 county from which a contribution, gift, or donation was received.
- Sec. 9. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for
- 18 a federal grant if those funds are to be used for the purposes
- 19 described under section 5.
- 20 Sec. 11. The money in the fund that is available for
- 21 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money in the fund at
- 22 the close of the year shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse
- 23 to the general fund.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 25 Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5739 (request no. 05872'18)
- 26 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
