SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6206

A bill to amend 2012 PA 487, entitled "Wildlife depredations indemnification act," by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 285.362 and 285.363).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the commission of agriculture and rural
- 3 development.
- 4 (b) "Department" means the department of agriculture and rural
- 5 development.
- 6 (c) "Livestock" means that term as it is defined in section $\frac{5}{}$
- 7 3 of the animal industry act, 1988 PA 466, MCL 287.705.MCL 287.703.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) The department shall provide indemnification for
- 9 the death, injury, or loss of livestock from wolves, coyotes, and
- 10 cougars. Indemnification for missing animals shall only be paid if

- 1 there is a history of losses to the owner of livestock as evidenced
- 2 by a prior payment by the department due to the death or injury of
- 3 livestock from wolves.
- 4 (2) To be eligible for indemnification under subsection (1),
- 5 the owner of livestock shall do all of the following:
- 6 (a) Report the incident to the department within 24 hours
- 7 after the animal is discovered to be dead, injured, or missing.
- 8 (b) File a claim for indemnification with the department
- 9 verifying the type and number of animals for which indemnification
- 10 is sought. The verification may include photographs of the animals
- 11 or tracks or other information that provides support for the claim.
- 12 If the claim seeks indemnification for missing animals, a notarized
- 13 statement from the owner specifying the date of birth of each
- 14 missing animal and the date on which the animals were discovered
- 15 missing, along with evidence of prior indemnification payments due
- 16 to death or injury of livestock from wolves, is sufficient
- 17 documentation that 1 or more animals are missing and eligible for
- 18 indemnification.
- 19 (c) Upon request, provide the department of natural resources
- 20 with access to the owner's property as necessary to conduct an
- 21 investigation if the department of natural resources believes that
- 22 an on-site visit will assist its investigation.
- 23 (d) Upon request, provide the department with documentation
- 24 that the animals have official identification, if required under
- 25 the animal industry act, 1988 PA 466, MCL 287.701 to
- 26 287.746.287.747.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

- after the date it is enacted into law. 1
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 2
- unless House Bill No. 6205 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into 3
- law.
