SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5646

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 5090 (MCL 168.5090), as added by 1994 PA 441.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5090. (1) The secretary of state shall direct and
- 2 supervise the establishment and maintenance of a statewide
- 3 qualified voter file. The secretary of state shall establish the
- 4 technology to implement the qualified voter file. on or before
- 5 January 1, 1997. The qualified voter file shall be IS the official
- 6 file for the conduct of all elections held in this state. on or
- 7 after January 1, 1998. The secretary of state may direct that all
- 8 or any part of the city , OR township , or village registration
- 9 files shall MUST be used in conjunction with the qualified voter
- 10 file at the first state primary and election held after the

- 1 creation of the qualified voter file.
- 2 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 3 contrary, beginning January 1, 1998, a person AN INDIVIDUAL who
- 4 appears to vote in an election and whose name appears in the
- 5 qualified voter file for that city, township, village, or school
- 6 district is considered a registered voter of that city, township,
- 7 village, or school district under this act.
- **8** (3) The secretary of state, a designated voter registration
- 9 agency, or a county, city, OR township , or village clerk shall not
- 10 place a name of an individual into the qualified voter file unless
- 11 that person_INDIVIDUAL signs an application as prescribed in
- 12 section 509r(3). The secretary of state or a designated voter
- 13 registration agency shall not allow a person AN INDIVIDUAL to
- 14 indicate a different address than the address in either the
- 15 secretary of state's or designated voter registration agency's
- 16 files to be placed in the qualified voter file.
- 17 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP AND UTILIZE A PROCESS

- 19 SECURITY ADMINISTRATION'S DEATH MASTER FILE THAT IS USED TO CANCEL
- 20 AN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE MICHIGAN
- 21 VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923, OR AN OFFICIAL
- 22 STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER 1972 PA 222, MCL
- 23 28.291 TO 28.300, OF A DECEASED RESIDENT OF THIS STATE IS ALSO USED
- 24 AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH TO UPDATE THE QUALIFIED VOTER FILE TO CANCEL
- 25 THE VOTER REGISTRATION OF ANY ELECTOR DETERMINED TO BE DECEASED.
- 26 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAKE THE CANCELED VOTER REGISTRATION
- 27 INFORMATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AVAILABLE TO THE CLERK OF EACH

- 1 CITY OR TOWNSHIP TO ASSIST WITH THE CLERK'S OBLIGATIONS UNDER
- 2 SECTION 510.
- (5) SUBJECT TO THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL 3
- 4 PARTICIPATE WITH OTHER STATES IN 1 OR MORE RECOGNIZED MULTISTATE
- PROGRAMS OR SERVICES, IF AVAILABLE, TO ASSIST IN THE VERIFICATION 5
- OF THE CURRENT RESIDENCE AND VOTER REGISTRATION STATUS OF ELECTORS.
- THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY RECOGNIZED 7
- MULTISTATE PROGRAM OR SERVICE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION THAT 8
- REQUIRES THIS STATE TO PROMOTE OR ADOPT LEGISLATION AS A CONDITION 9
- OF PARTICIPATION IN THAT PROGRAM OR SERVICE. IN ADDITION, THE 10
- 11 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY RECOGNIZED
- 12 MULTISTATE PROGRAM OR SERVICE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION IF THE
- SECRETARY OF STATE DETERMINES THAT DATA OF THAT PROGRAM OR SERVICE 13
- ARE NOT BEING ADEQUATELY SECURED OR PROTECTED. THE SECRETARY OF 14
- STATE SHALL FOLLOW THE PROCEDURES UNDER SECTION 509AA(5) WITH 15
- REGARD TO ANY ELECTORS AFFECTED BY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH ANY 16
- 17 MULTISTATE PROGRAM OR SERVICE.
