## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 903

A bill to require that certain remedial actions be taken by certain individuals who are notified of suspected sexual assaults of postsecondary students; to prohibit certain individuals who learn of possible sexual assaults of postsecondary students from discouraging those students from reporting the incidents to appropriate authorities; to provide for the protection of postsecondary students who are sexually assaulted; and to prescribe penalties.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "postsecondary student protection act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Postsecondary educational institution" means a degree- or

- 1 certificate-granting public or private college or university,
- 2 junior college, or community college that is located in this state.
- 3 (b) "Postsecondary interscholastic athletic activity" means a
- 4 program or event offered by a postsecondary educational
- 5 institution, including practice and competition, during which
- 6 athletes participate or practice to participate in an organized
- 7 athletic game or competition against another school, team, club,
- 8 entity, or individual.
- 9 (c) "Sexual assault" means an act, attempted act, or
- 10 conspiracy to engage in an act of criminal conduct as defined in
- 11 section 520b, 520c, 520d, 520e, or 520g of the Michigan penal code,
- 12 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520b, 750.520c, 750.520d, 750.520e, and
- **13** 750.520g.
- 14 (d) "Student" means an individual who is at least 18 years of
- 15 age and who is enrolled in an educational program at a
- 16 postsecondary educational institution or is a participant in a
- 17 postsecondary interscholastic athletic activity.
- 18 Sec. 3. (1) If an individual who is at least 18 years of age
- 19 and who is employed in a professional capacity at a postsecondary
- 20 educational institution or is paid to conduct postsecondary
- 21 interscholastic athletic activities is notified by a student that
- 22 the student may have been the victim of a sexual assault, the
- 23 individual shall inform the student of all of the following:
- 24 (a) All resources and services provided by the postsecondary
- 25 educational institution for victims of sexual assault.
- 26 (b) State and local resources and services for victims of
- 27 sexual assault, including, but not limited to, the website location

- 1 of "A Resource Handbook for Campus Sexual Assault Survivors,
- 2 Friends and Family", published in 2018 by the office of the
- 3 governor in conjunction with the first lady of Michigan.
- 4 (2) A postsecondary educational institution shall make
- 5 reasonable efforts to notify those who provide volunteer services
- 6 to the institution of the duties described in subsection (1) for
- 7 certain employees of the institution and shall encourage those
- 8 volunteers to perform those duties in the same manner as required
- 9 of those employees.
- 10 Sec. 4. If an individual who is at least 18 years of age and
- 11 who is employed in a professional capacity at a postsecondary
- 12 educational institution or is paid to conduct postsecondary
- 13 interscholastic athletic activities has direct knowledge that a
- 14 student likely has been the victim of a sexual assault at the
- 15 institution or while attending or participating in any program,
- 16 activity, or event sponsored or otherwise provided or supported by
- 17 the institution, that individual shall not, by pressure, coercion,
- 18 or any other means, willfully or knowingly attempt to discourage
- 19 the student from reporting the incident to any appropriate
- 20 authorities. An individual who violates this section is guilty of a
- 21 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 24 date it is enacted into law.
