## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 956

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 28.304), as amended by 2018 PA 47.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced
- 2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification
- 3 card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her
- 4 full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of
- 5 birth, social security SOCIAL SECURITY number, residence address,
- 6 PROOF OF ENROLLMENT IN THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM UNDER
- 7 THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM ACT, IF APPLICABLE, and a
- 8 photographic identity document. An applicant may choose to apply
- 9 for a standard driver license or standard official state personal
- 10 identification card or an enhanced driver license or enhanced state

- 1 personal identification card.
- 2 (2) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 3 personal identification card shall include reasonable security
- 4 measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal
- 5 information regarding residents of this state that is contained in
- 6 the enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 7 identification card.
- 8 (3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 9 personal identification card may include radio frequency
- 10 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned
- 11 number, which shall be encrypted if agreed to by the Department of
- 12 Homeland Security, and does not include biometric data. The
- 13 secretary of state shall ensure that the radio frequency
- 14 identification technology is secure from unauthorized data access
- 15 and includes reasonable security measures to protect against
- 16 unauthorized disclosure of personal information. An applicant must
- 17 sign a declaration acknowledging his or her understanding of the
- 18 radio frequency identification technology before he or she is
- 19 issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 20 personal identification card.
- 21 (4) The requirements of this act are in addition to the
- 22 requirements otherwise imposed on individuals who apply for a
- 23 standard driver license or standard official state personal
- 24 identification card.
- 25 (5) The holder of an enhanced driver license issued under this
- 26 act is subject to every licensing sanction provided under the
- 27 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923. As used

- 1 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction,
- 2 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition
- 3 of points to a driving record; until October 1, 2018, the
- 4 assessment of a driver responsibility fee; the assessment of a
- 5 civil fine or criminal penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil
- 6 infraction determination; the imposition of probationary terms and
- 7 conditions; or any other penalty provided under the Michigan
- 8 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.
- 9 (6) BEGINNING ON FEBRUARY 16, 2021, UPON RECEIPT OF A NOTICE
- 10 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL THAT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO
- 11 HAS BEEN ISSUED AN ENHANCED DRIVER LICENSE OR ENHANCED OFFICIAL
- 12 STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS ACT HAS BEEN
- 13 CERTIFIED AS A PARTICIPANT IN THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM,
- 14 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ISSUE A CORRECTED ENHANCED DRIVER
- 15 LICENSE OR ENHANCED OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD TO
- 16 THAT INDIVIDUAL BY MAILING THE LICENSE OR CARD TO HIS OR HER
- 17 DESIGNATED ADDRESS. THE ENHANCED DRIVER LICENSE OR ENHANCED
- 18 OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL DISPLAY THE
- 19 INDIVIDUAL'S DESIGNATED ADDRESS AND SHALL NOT DISPLAY THE
- 20 INDIVIDUAL'S RESIDENCE ADDRESS. THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION
- 21 ARE IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ISSUED
- 22 A CORRECTED STANDARD DRIVER LICENSE UNDER SECTION 310F OF THE
- 23 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310F, OR A CORRECTED
- 24 OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER SECTION 2A OF
- 25 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.292A. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION:
- 26 (A) "ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM AS THAT
- 27 TERM IS DEFINED IN THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM ACT.

- 1 (B) "DESIGNATED ADDRESS" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN THE
- 2 ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM ACT.
- 3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
- 4 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 5 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 6 unless Senate Bill No. 655 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- 7 law.
