

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4213

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 1116.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1116. (1) A city, village, or township may approve, by a
2 majority of the city, village, or township's legislative body
3 voting, a resolution to allow the sale of alcoholic liquor for
4 consumption on the premises between the hours of 2 a.m. and 4 a.m.

5 (2) The commission may issue a late night permit for the sale
6 of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises between the
7 hours of 2 a.m. and 4 a.m. to a licensee that holds a license or
8 permit that allows for the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption
9 on the premises that is located in a city, village, or township



1 that has approved a resolution described in subsection (1).

2 (3) A licensee described in subsection (2) may apply for a
3 late night permit on a form prescribed by the commission. The
4 initial and annual renewal fee for a late night permit issued under
5 this section is \$250.00. A late night permit issued under this
6 section expires on the same date as the license or permit described
7 in subsection (2) and may be renewed in conjunction with that
8 license or permit.

9 (4) This section does not apply after 3 years after the
10 effective date of the amendatory act that added this section.
