## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 96

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 139 (MCL 750.139), as amended by 1998 PA 510.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 139. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a child an
- 2 individual under 16-18 years of age while under arrest,
- 3 confinement, or conviction for any a crime , shall must not be
- 4 placed in any an apartment or cell of any a prison or place of
- 5 confinement with any adult 1 or more adults who is are under
- 6 arrest, confinement, or conviction for any a crime, or be permitted
- 7 to remain in any court room during the trial of adults, or be
- 8 transported in any a vehicle of transportation in company used to
- 9 transport inmates with adults charged with or convicted of a crime.





- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to prisoners being
   transported to or from, or confined in a youth correctional
   facility operated by the department of corrections or a private
   vendor under section 20g of the corrections code of 1953, 1953 PA
   232, MCL 791.220g.
- 6 (3) All cases involving the commitment or trial of children
  7 individuals under 16—18 years of age for any crime or misdemeanor,
  8 before any court, shall must be heard and determined by the court
  9 at a suitable time, to be designated by it, designated by the
  10 court, separate and apart from the trial of other criminal cases.
- 11 (4) Any A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
