## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5721

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

by amending section 34060 (MCL 500.34060), as amended by 2016 PA 276, and by adding section 3406v.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 34060. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, or renews in this state a health insurance policy that provides coverage for prescription drugs and limits those benefits to drugs included in a formulary shall do all of the following:
- 5 (a) Provide for participation of participating physicians,6 dentists, and pharmacists in the development of the formulary.
- 7 (b) Disclose to health care providers and upon request to8 insureds the nature of the formulary restrictions.





- 1 (c) Provide for exceptions from the formulary limitation when 2 a nonformulary alternative is a medically necessary and appropriate 3 alternative. This subdivision does not prevent an insurer from 4 establishing prior authorization requirements or another process 5 for consideration of coverage or higher cost-sharing for 6 nonformulary alternatives.
- 7 (2) On a request for an expedited review of coverage for a 8 nonformulary alternative based on exigent circumstances, an insurer 9 shall make a determination and notify the enrollee or the 10 enrollee's designee and the prescribing physician, or other 11 prescriber, as appropriate, of the determination within 24 hours after the insurer receives all information necessary to determine 12 13 whether the exception should be granted. For purposes of this 14 subsection, exigent circumstances exist when an enrollee is 15 suffering from a health condition that may seriously jeopardize the 16 enrollee's life, health, or ability to regain maximum function or when an enrollee is undergoing a current course of treatment using 17 18 a nonformulary drug.
  - (3) If subsection (2) does not apply, an insurer shall make a determination on coverage for a nonformulary alternative and notify the enrollee or the enrollee's designee and the prescribing physician, or other prescriber, as appropriate, of the determination within 72 hours after the insurer receives all information necessary to determine whether the exception should be granted.
    - (4) This section is subject to section 3406v.
- Sec. 3406v. Beginning on the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section, and until June 30, 2021, an insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, or renews in this state a

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- health insurance policy that provides coverage for prescription 1 2 drugs shall do both of the following:
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- (a) Provide coverage for an emergency refill of up to a 60-day 4 supply of any noncontrolled maintenance medication.
- (b) Provide coverage for an early refill of any 30-day or 60-5
- 6 day prescription maintenance drug to allow for up to a 90-day
- 7 supply, without regard to whether the pharmacy is mail order or in
- 8 person.
